Dear Sir:

In accordance with the action of the board on May 16, 1947, I have made the following arrangements with Mr. Emmett W. Gulley:

- (1) He is to act as custodian of the Herbert Hoover house in Newberg with full authority to look after the house and grounds and make necessary repairs for the preservation thereof and for the protection of the Foundation. For doing so he is to be allowed to occupy the house rent free.
- (2) He is to act as financial agent in raising funds for the Foundation. He is to choose his own time and plan of procedure. He will render you bills for services and expenses. His compensation is to be at the rate of \$10 per day and expenses.
- (3) The Foundation is to advance him money for expenses as he may request.
- (4) You will determine the form of a receipt you wish for such payments.
