CROSS COUNTRY

The first cross country championships for the nation's smaller colleges were held at the University of Omaha in November of 1956.

The following year, 1957, saw the field increased with entries of 85 men from 24 colleges for the 4-mile grind over the Elmwood Park Golf Course adjacent to Omaha University.

The interest and work of Ernie Gorr of the University of Omaha, who has directed all 10 meets, and the cooperation of his institution have succeeded in making this a growing event on the NAIA calendar.

The 1965 entry list totaled a record 174 runners with 42 schools represented, 22 of which entered full teams.

The interest and work of Ernie Gorr of the University of Omaha, who has directed all nine meets, and the cooperation of his institution have succeeded in making this a growing event on the NAIA calendar.
