Dear Friend:--

I am enclosing account of the expenditure of the \$100.00 sent by Mrs. Herbert Hoover, to be used as I thought best for the good of the college. It has been spread over a good deal of time, and over a good deal of territory, too.

Having this money has enabled me to do some things which otherwise I might not have felt that I could do, in the way of meeting and giving some entertainment to Friends who were friends of the college. I think I have made this profitable to the college, as one of these friends gave me \$100.00 and another one \$200.00, and both helped me to other money, actual or prospective.

I suspect it might be advantageous if somebody would put another \$100.00 in my hands for use in the same sort of way, as I know some other presidents of colleges in Oregon have had, though the sums were larger. But I don't know just where to look for the other hundred.
