We are happy to announce to you that the Alumni Association of George Fox College is sponsoring a concert by the Four Flats Quartet on Sunday, January 28, at 3:00 p.m. at the Newberg High School gymnasium.

The Four Flats began singing together in 1946 while students at George Fox College. Members of the quartet are Dick Cadd, Ronald Crecelius, Norval Hadley, and Harlow Ankeny. During their college career they gained acceptance in the Northwest as well as across the nation. They were well known for their barbershop-style entertainment, but equally as famous for their spiritual emphasis. Following their graduation they entered separate fields of service, continuing their singing on a parttime basis. During this time they travelled some in the interest of missions. Opportunity later came for them to give full time to music and evangelism for a few years as the World Vision Quartet. However, since 1962 they have been occupied in separate areas of endeavor.

Currently the members of the quartet are engaged in the following ministries:

Harlow Ankeny is manager of the Barclay Press located in Newberg, Oregon.
