## WHO RETREATS?

Jesus said to His disciples, "Come ye apart." The Christian needs to insert a "comma" in the sentence of his life—he needs to pause for renewal.

Retreat, as the word implies, is a temporary withdrawal from the mainstream of life—a time for you to meditate, study, interact, and take inventory of your life. The idea is to reenter the mainstream with renewed purpose and understanding of God's will in your life.

## MAY WE HELP YOU WITH PROGRAMMING?

We have found from our years of experience that the combination of *setting, leadership, program, and spirit in which people come* is used by the Lord to strengthen participants. The director and other resource people are available to help you in all aspects of retreat planning:

- Retreat planning and training, and consultation in program aids—using small groups, team-building initiative activities, or drawing from a library of selected books and cassette tapes.
- Help in programming through speaking, or supervising recreation.
- Directing and programming of entire weekend.



### DIRECTIONS TO TILIKUM FROM NEWBERG

In Newberg turn north at intersection of Highway 99W and Highway 240 (Chehalem Valley sign). Follow Highway 240 for five miles. Turn right (N) leaving 240 at Gaston/Laurelwood sign. After one mile, bear left at junction onto North Valley Road. Look for camp sign on right (one mile).

## RATES

One night (includes lodging, grounds use, three meals, insurance), per person . . . . . \$28

Two nights (lodging, grounds use, five meals, insurance), per person . . . . . \$42

Evening snack—upon request

Deposit—\$150 accompanying application validates reservation. Deposit will be applied to total charges, which are due at the end of the retreat. The deposit is not refundable.

Minimum guarantee of 28 people on weekends.

Minimum retreat charges (weekends)—28 people multiplied by the per-person rate.

Day or evening use of retreat center . . . . . \$30

Luncheons and/or dinners by special arrangement.

Rates are as of 11/88 and are subject to change.

## RENTAL AGREEMENT

1. Campers will provide their own towels and bedding.
2. Youth groups through high school will be accompanied by adequate adult leadership.
3. Use of tobacco is discouraged because of health dangers and fire hazard. Smokers are requested to smoke outside.
4. The possession or use of alcoholic beverages or nonprescribed drugs is prohibited.
5. Rooms will be in order when checking out.
6. The group will be responsible for breakage and destruction of camp property.
7. The renting group is as responsible to fulfill the reservation agreement as Tilikum is to fulfill its part in providing the service. We are here because of our commitment to provide a ministry to you. Our rates are set in relation to providing this ministry. A cancellation within eight weeks of the scheduled activity jeopardizes the delicate balance of meeting operating costs. If a cancellation is made within eight weeks of the scheduled retreat date, the canceling group is accountable for 75 percent of the minimum retreat charges.

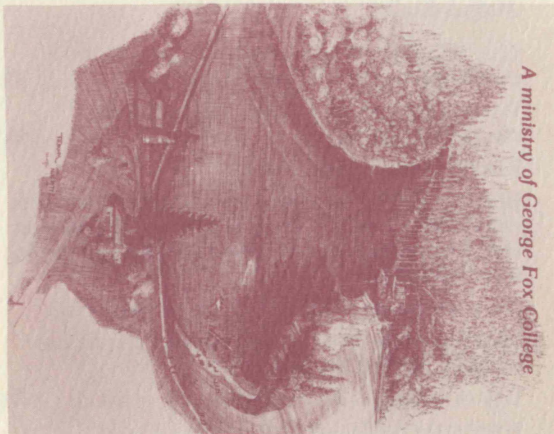

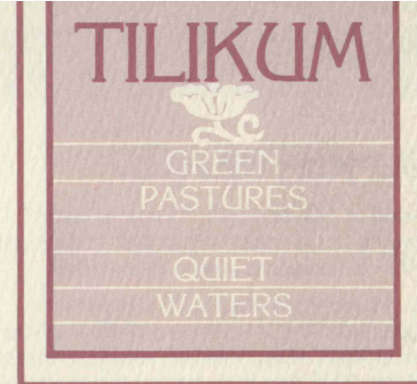

## CENTER FOR RETREATS

Tilikum, an interdenominational, nonprofit retreat center, is a ministry of George Fox College, Newberg, Oregon. Tilikum is located in the Chehalem Valley, 7 miles northwest of Newberg, a 45-minute drive from Portland and Salem.

Tilikum functions as a support organization to the Christian community, serving as a center for creative ideas in outdoor ministries.

## TILIKUM OFFERS:

### GROUNDS

A quiet country setting, 77 acres of woods and meadows for rambling, and a 15-acre lake for water recreation.

### FACILITIES

"Bakers' Illahee," accommodating 43 overnight guests, has three carpeted meeting rooms with fireplaces, audio-visual system, seven rooms for sleeping, dining room/solarium, and recreation rooms.

### FOOD SERVICE

Home-style cooked meals are provided so that group members can participate fully in the program and be assured of nutritious meals prepared by an experienced food service team.

### RECREATION

Recreation is not designed to be the main feature of a weekend retreat. Times will be provided for participating in relaxing activities. These include outdoor activities like walking, canoeing, fishing, swimming; indoor table games, pool, and foosball; and things like volleyball, box hockey, basketball, and campfires in the Multipurpose Building.
