BRUINS-BOXERS RAINED OUT, RESCHEDULED FOR APRIL 17

NEWBERG, Ore. --- Wet courts forced a postponement of the Northwest Conference tennis match between the George Fox University Bruins and the Pacific University Boxers which was to have been played Thursday (Apr. 12) in Forest Grove, Ore. The match has been rescheduled for Tuesday, April 17, at 3:00 p.m. at Pacific.

The match will be the final regular season contest for both teams. George Fox is 2-12 overall and 1-11 in the NWC, with their only league win a 9-0 decision over Pacific in Newberg on March 22. As the 8th and 9th-place teams in the conference, the two teams will probably face each other again in a playoff round to start the Northwest Conference Tennis Tournament, which is set for Friday-Saturday, April 20-21, at the Yakima Tennis Club in Yakima, Wash.

HEAD COACH RICK CRUZ (George Fox '98) is 2-12 (.143) in his 1st year as women's tennis coach at his alma mater. He also serves as head coach for the Bruin men's tennis team.

NEWBERG, Ore. --- In their final regular season home match of the 2001 season, the George Fox University Bruins dropped a 7-2 decision to the Lewis & Clark College Pioneers in a Northwest Conference women's tennis match here Wednesday afternoon (Apr. 4) at the GFU campus courts.

The Bruins managed to capture one match in each of the singles and doubles categories. In singles, the lone George Fox win came as **Kim Reimer (Sr., Dallas, Ore.)** defeated Kerianne Barton 7-5, 6-3 at #3. Pioneer winners were Joy Leising over **Lisa Trefts (Fr., Spokane, Wash.)** 6-3, 1-6, 6-4 at #1; Lindsay Hogan over **Stephanie Selid (Fr., Portland, Ore.)** 3-6, 6-2, 7-6 at #2; Desiree Miller over **Anne Robinson (Fr., Wilson, Wyo.)** 6-2, 6-1 at #4; Megan Roseman over **Kristin Miller (Fr., Pendleton, Ore.)** 6-3, 6-1 at #5; and Camille Arbuckle over **Keri Ingraham (So., Edmonds, Wash.)** 6-3, 6-1 at #6.

Lewis & Clark also won the top two doubles matches, Leising and Miller defeating Trefts and Reimer 8-4 at #1, and Barton and Roseman combining to down Selid and Robinson 8-2 at #2. George Fox took the #3 doubles as Miller and Ingraham teamed up for a 9-7 win over Hogan and Arbuckle.

SALEM, Ore. --- Rain and being a player short conspired against the George Fox University women's tennis team here Thursday afternoon (Apr. 5), as the Bruins dropped a 6-0 decision to the Willamette University Bearcats in a Northwest Conference match.

With **Anne Robinson**, normally the team's #4 singles and a #2 doubles player, unavailable to make the trip, the Bruins were forced to juggle their lineup. The match opened with Willamette winning the #1 doubles match, Jessie Hughes and Simmie Muth defeating **Lisa Trefts** and **Kim Reimer** 8-4, and the #2 doubles, Lori Bokovoy and Jamie Muth over **Kristin Miller** and **Stephanie Selid** 8-1. WITH NOWHERE TO GO BUT UP, BRUINS BEGIN CLIMB UP NWC LADDER

After a 1-16 season and a ninth-place finish in the Northwest Conference at 0-12, there is nowhere left for the George Fox University women's tennis team to go but up – and if new coach **Rick Cruz**, who also coaches the men's team, is correct, that's exactly where the 2001 Bruin team is heading.

"I can guarantee you we won't finish last this season," insists Cruz as he takes over the women's program from Mark Sendelback, who returned to full-time ministry with Youth for Christ in the Washington County area west of Portland. "We've got some new players this year who are very talented – all they lack is experience – and I think we'll see a significant improvement in this year's team."

The Bruins lost seven letterwinners from last year's squad, the most important being No. 1 singles player Rachel McComb, a senior and All-Conference Second Team selection who impressed opposing coaches with her hard-nosed style despite only a 3-13 record. Also gone are Kelly Chrisman (2-15 at No. 3), Emily Winans (1-8 at No. 4), Jacie Catandella (2-14 at No. 5), and Kelsey Shontz (4-12 at No. 6).

There are two returnees from last year: **Kim Reimer (Sr., Dallas, Ore.)**, who was 6-11 at No. 2 singles and could have even more success at No. 3 this year, and **Keri Ingraham (So., Edmonds, Wash.)**, who was 0-3 in limited time at No. 6. Ingraham has shown major improvement and will likely take over full-time at the No. 6 spot.

"Kim is our most experienced player," notes Cruz, "so we will be counting on her to provide us with some much-needed team leadership."

Expected to replace McComb at No. 1 singles is **Lisa Trefts (Fr., Spokane, Wash., Shadle Park HS)**, whom Cruz believes some day will be among the best players in the conference. "She gives us a solid No. 1 who will compete hard every time out, even if she is not among the conference 'elite' just yet."

The rest of the lineup will consist of freshmen who will get their college 'baptism under fire'. **Stephanie Selid (Portland, Ore., Sunset HS)** is the top candidate for the No. 2 position, **Anne Robinson (Wilson, Wyo., Jackson Hole HS)** will fill in at No. 4, and **Kristin Miller (Pendleton, Ore., Pendleton HS)** should step in at No. 5. Also available is **Brandi Hess (So., Boise, Idaho)**, a good all-around athlete.

"Reimer, Selid, and Robinson are all very close, talent-wise", says Cruz, "and I would expect to switch them around some in 2-3-4 positions, depending on who is playing well at the time."

In doubles, Trefts and Robinson will give the Bruins a strong combination at No. 1, Selid and Reimer will pair up at No. 2, and Miller and Ingraham will hold forth at No. 3.

"As young as we are, there's no way we're going to challenge the upper level of our conference right now, the Pacific Lutherans and Linfields," Cruz admits. "Sixth, maybe even

fifth, is not an unrealistic goal for this team, however. I think we're on the right track toward developing a quality program here.

"The players we have this year work hard, get along well, and have good attitudes -- they're developing a mentality that winning is important, so I think we'll be more competitive in a lot of matches than we've ever been before. This could be a good year for us. We certainly have the potential to be the best women's tennis team George Fox has had."
