The lady say, I was hoping long time to have ooloo made, so I got it now. Suppose we get together, become wife and husband and when out whaling this spring and caught whale. And after whaling we put up big feast for all people at Point Hope. After feast we had Na-lou-ka-tuk, we have dance together, I wonder how we will look like when we dance together, so they started Eskimo dance. After they dance lady turn around and face young man and said to him, I'm sorry, I not going to become your wife, because you don't know how to do Eskimo dance." So the lady took the ooloo and let the young man go.
