15 Year Day Camp Celebration: August 2, 1986

From that first summer in 1972, with 2 staff members and 341 campers, Tilikum's day camp program has grown to be one of the largest of its kind in the Northwest. By the end of this summer, 15 years later, more than 11,000 children will have had an outdoor Christian day camp experience. <u>A celebration is in order!</u> Therefore, Saturday, August 2 is being set aside for former campers, counselors and staff to come home to a Tilikum 15 year reunion. Slides from many years will be shown. Various theme displays will be at the Multipurpose Building - remember those huge farm overalls we signed and the gigantic quilt we made? Come at 10 a.m. - stay 'til dark. Bring your own lunch, and then, if you make reservations, we'll grill hamburgers for you for supper. Boating, swimming, big swing, farm animals, and lots of memories are offered. If you can't make it, send a note telling us about some interesting experience you remember. We will enter your notes in a scrapbook of memories, so we would like to hear from you.

Saturday, September 13, 1986, is a special day of teaching and celebration. This day is designed to encourage and strengthen your faith and to help you live a freer, more joyful, more committed Christian life. Ken Medema's music, both in concert and on record, for many years has challenged, nudged, and encouraged his listeners to new depths of commitment and new heights of joy. The comfortable and ample facilities of George Fox College make an ideal setting for the event. The entire event - day time workshops and evening concert - can be attended for \$15. If you wish to attend <u>either</u> the workshops <u>or</u> the evening concert the fee is \$10.
