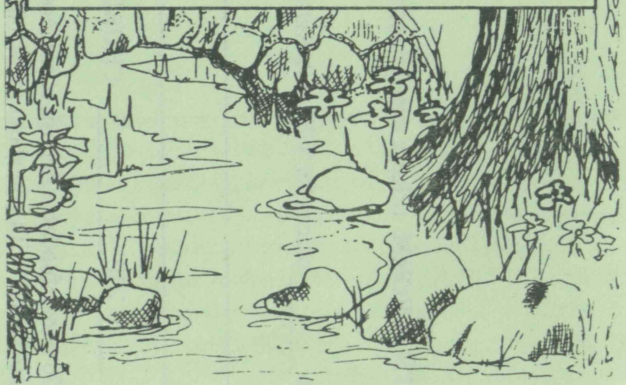


Houseplants and other growing things need tender loving care to ensure the full growth, beauty, and pleasure the grower desires
