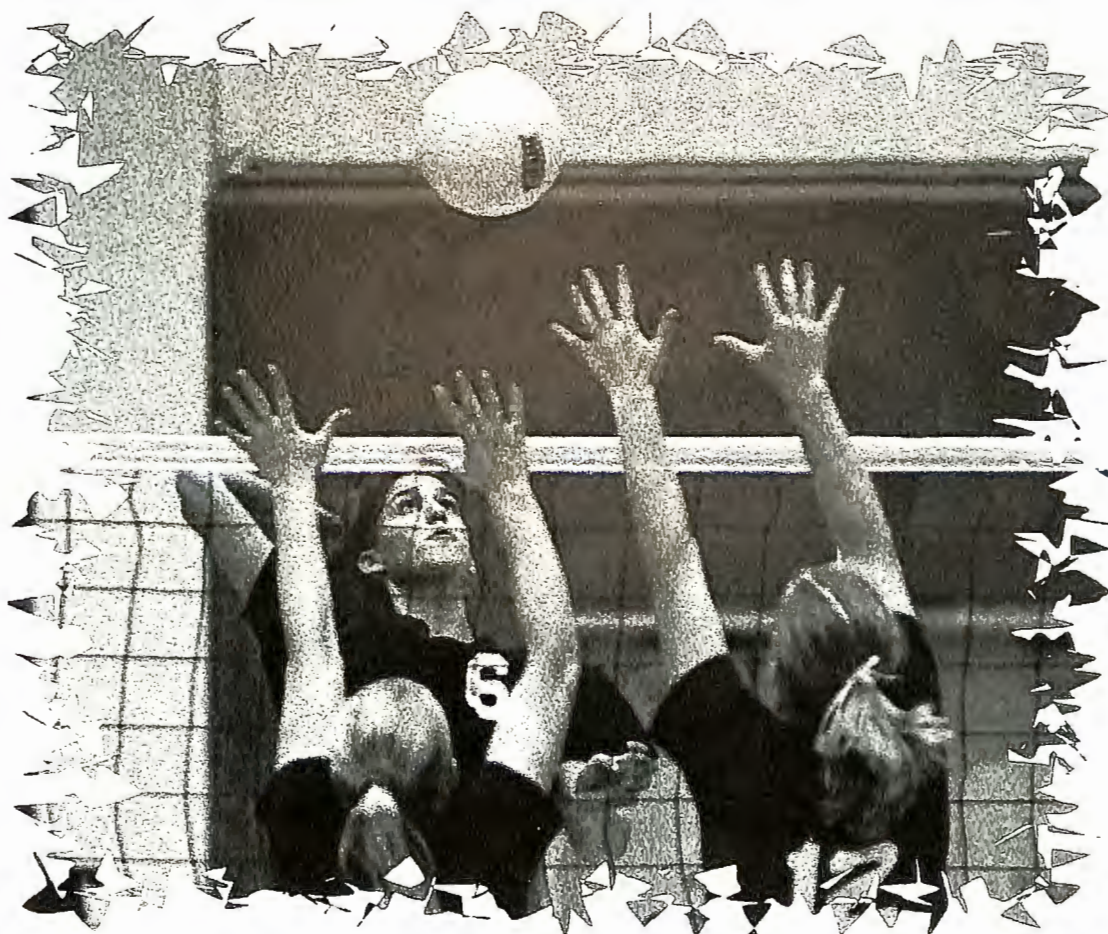

George Fox Starts 1998 with High Hopes and National Ranking

With the nucleus of last year's 23-5 team returning, George Fox University's volleyball squad begins the season ranked No. 8 in the NAIA national poll, its first-ever national ranking.

Does that mean this is George Fox's best team ever?

"So much of what this team recognition entails is what last year's team did," says 17-year head coach Steve Grant. "It's nice to be recognized, but we still have to prove our worth on the court. If anything at this point, this is the team with the greatest potential. If we are ranked in the top 20 at the end of the season, that's what is going to be significant. That is what will separate this team from the others."

The Lady Bruins return eight players who saw regular playing time last season, including outside hitter **Sharon Barnett (Jr., Salem Academy, Ore.)**, an NAIA Pacific Northwest Region first-team selection last year.

"This is a veteran team," says Grant. "It's not going to experience the growing pains younger ones do."

George Fox's other award-winning returner is Barnett's former high school teammate, middle hitter **Beth Davis (Jr., Salem Academy, Ore.)**, who was an all-Northwest Conference honorable mention pick. Davis's middle hitter counterpart will be **Amy Schultens (Sr., The Dalles HS, Ore.)**.

George Fox graduated 1995 all-conference first team setter Kari Guyer, but shouldn't drop off at her position

since **Jennie Rennie (Sr., Curtis HS, Tacoma, Wash.)** took over the starting role midway through last year when Guyer was out with an injury. Perhaps Grant's biggest concern is the team's lack of an experienced back-up.

The Lady Bruins also lose Michelle Harper, an all-Northwest Conference second team outside hitter, but won't be shorthanded. Grant returns plenty of experience in outside hitters **Jen Schultens (Sr., The Dalles HS, Ore.)** and **Charysse Chowning (Jr., Bend HS, Ore.)**.

At the defensive specialist position, George Fox will rely upon **Rachel Evans (Sr., Hawaii Baptist HS, Kaneohe, Hawaii)** and **Coby Van der Meer (Sr., Sam Barlow HS, Boring, Ore.)**, who both averaged 3.0 digs a game last season.

Grant expects to find some playing time for his newcomers. Middle hitter **Wendy Clark (Jr., Bainbridge Island HS, Wash.)** was named NWAACC Northern Region MVP at Skagit Valley College and outside hitter/defensive specialist **Brandy Mailer (Fr., Kamehameha HS, Honolulu, Hawaii)** won all-state honorable mention for the Hawaii state championships. Outside hitter **Heidi Vander Stoep (Fr., Woodland HS, Wash.)** also was a member of a state championship team and earned first team all-Trico League honors. Outside hitters **Amy Forbes (So., Jackson Hole HS, Wyo.)** and **Stacie Wilton (Jr., Tigard HS, Ore.)** move up from the junior varsity along with setter **Tristan Nicholas (Jr., Stanwood HS, Camano Island, Wash.)**.

In its final year before earning full membership in NCAA Div. III, George Fox will compete as an NAIA independent.

George Fox Hits Few Obstacles During 23-5 Season

1997 was a season without much drama. George Fox efficiently ran over opponents while compiling a 23-5 record — the team's best record in recent history.

The season can be described quite simply. The Lady Bruins divided their five losses between two nationally ranked opponents, while using their depth to overpower everyone else on the schedule. George Fox advanced to the Northwest Conference championship game for the second time in three years, but fell 16-14, 17-15, 15-9 to national-tournament-bound University of Puget Sound.

Head coach Steve Grant regularly played his entire roster while posting the best winning percentage in his 16-year career. Not once did a match

extend past four games. In 18 of the matches, the Lady Bruins swept to victory without losing a game.

Three individuals were honored by the Northwest Conference. Sophomore outside hitter Sharon Barnett took first-team honors; senior outside hitter Michelle Harper was a second-team selection and sophomore middle hitter Beth Davis received honorable mention. Barnett went on to win all-region honors.

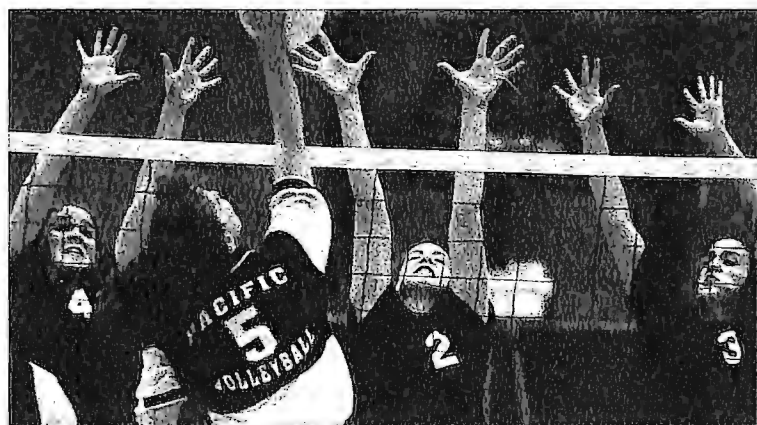

Over the last decade and a half, Steve Grant has established a winning volleyball program at George Fox.

Just once in his 16 seasons has one of his teams finished with a losing record. His teams have a 374-236 (.613) record under his guidance. They've won two National Christian College Athletic Association national championships (1984 and 1987), and each time he was named NCCAA national coach of the year. NAIA District 2 Coach of the Year honors came his way in 1984 and 1990.

George Fox no longer competes in the NCCAA or NAIA District 2, but his teams continue to win. George Fox has advanced to the championship game of the Northwest Conference twice in the last three years.

During the nineties, three of his athletes have won NAIA All-American awards, two also named NAIA All-American Scholar-Athletes.

Grant took the head volleyball coaching job in 1982. He served as basketball assistant coach until 1995.

Grant is a 1969 graduate of Biola University, where he was a three-sport athlete. As a guard for the basketball team, he was named team MVP both his junior and senior years. He earned first-team all-conference, all-district and all-Far West honors as an Eagle defender on the soccer team and played baseball his freshman and junior years.

After graduation, Grant stayed two years as a basketball and soccer assistant coach.

In 1971, Grant moved to Salem, Ore., to become head boy's basketball coach and head baseball coach at Salem Academy. In 1975, he switched from baseball to volleyball.

At Western Baptist College in 1981-82, Grant coached the women's

basketball team and was head men's soccer coach.

Grant earned a master's degree in education from Linfield College in 1985. In addition to coaching duties, he teaches courses as associate professor of health and human performance.

Grant and his wife, Kathy, live in Newberg and both work at George Fox. Kathy is an admission counselor for the Continuing Education Department. They have two children, Jeff, 26, and Bryan, 23.

Rueck was an all-league volleyball setter and established assist records at Port Angeles High School in Washington. She also was an all-state basketball guard before she moved on to play basketball at Skagit Valley Community College.

She earned her bachelor of arts degree in elementary education from George Fox in 1995.

Rueck teaches fifth grade in the Newberg School District. She and Scott Rueck, George Fox's women's basketball head coach, were married July 13, 1996. They live in Newberg.

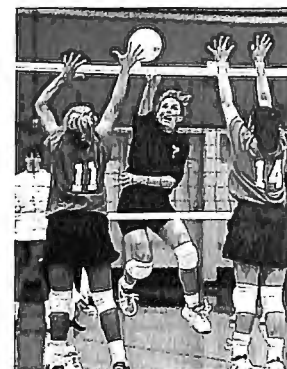
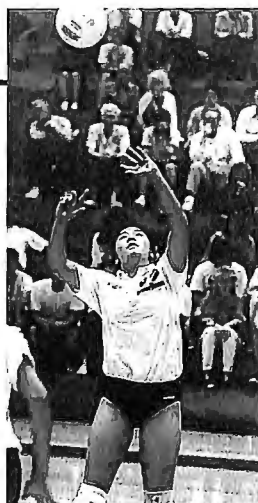

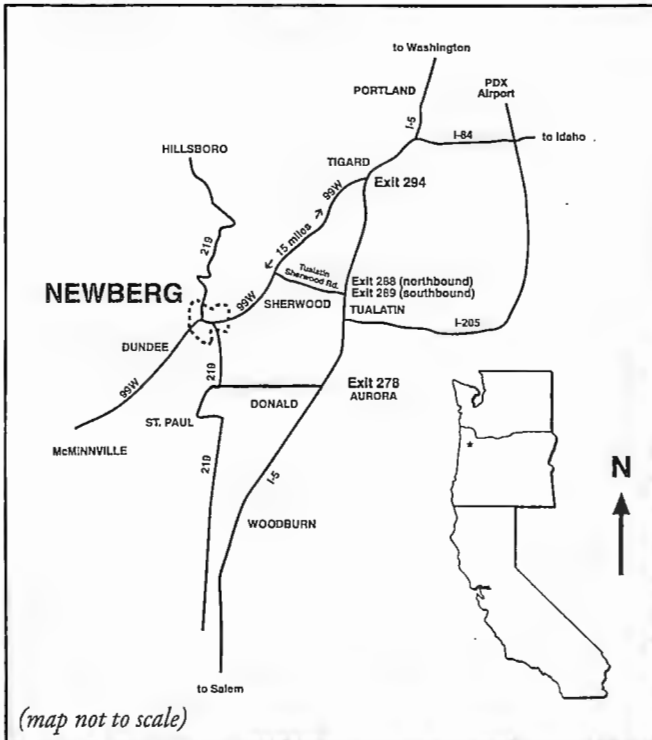
