### SCHIMMEL, LAMOREAUX HONORED

Oregon Collegiate Conference football boosted its morale 100 per cent this past weekend, picking up four victories. And the only loss was by George Fox to fellow member Oregon Tech in the first conference game on the schedule.

Oregon College, Eastern Oregon and Southern Oregon joined OTI in the win column in a sweep, which included two victories over Northwest Conference foes---OCE over Pacific and EOC over Whitman.

Eastern Oregon's Rollin Schimmel ranked as the outstanding individual performer, picking up 207 yards rushing in 19 carries, scoring three touchdowns, nailing a Whitman back in the end zone for a safety, blocking a conversion attempt and making 10 unassisted tackles.

His efforts earned BACK OF THE WEEK honors in the first week of competition. Schimmel, a 180-pound senior halfback from Rainier, missed most of last season with recurring injuries. His one-game total surpassed by 60 yards his 1965 season output.

Jon Lamoreaux, Oregon College defensive end, won LINEMAN OF THE WEEK accolades for his stellar toil in the win over Pacific. He recovered a fumble, intercepted a pass and was in the Badgers' backfield much of the night.

In games to date, OCC teams have outscored opponents, 166-65. The only conference game sends Oregon Tech to Oregon College.

SOC COMBINATION CLICKS--Southern Oregon's passing combination of quarterback Dan Miles and split end Jim Calhoun exploded last Saturday against Chico State, snapping three Oregon Collegiate Conference records.

Miles, in throwing 36 completions in 52 attempts, posted new standards in both categories and Calhoun's 14 receptions took care of that mark. The old attempt record was 41 by Lloyd Smith of OTI in 1964 and Miles owned the previous completion mark. Calhoun surpassed the 12 caught by ex-teammate Spike Gordon in 1965 against George Fox.

The SOC junior quarterback upped his passing yardage total to 548 for two games, thanks to a 292-yard effort.

The combined performance earned the pair lineman and back of the week awards, respectively.

One other record was approached when OTI's Bill Costa carried the ball 28 times, nearing the 30 Andy Berkis registered in 1964 for Portland State.

Other backs nominated for weekly honors included Jim McNelly, GF; Jim Moody, OTI; Tom Lewis, EOC; and Tom Hawkins, OCE. Other line selections include Lorren Zink, OCE; Mike Bech, EOC; Don McAllister, OTI; and Bob Hadlock, GF.

This week, Eastern Oregon returns to OCC action after a try at rugged Eastern Washington, the Mounts eager to regain the offense they mustered in an opening win over Whitman. But they run into Oregon Tech, still smarting from a lacing by Oregon College. OCE is at George Fox in the other loop game.

STURGIS, BECH REWARDED

Perennial champion Southern Oregon faces what appears to be its stiffest Oregon Collegiate Conference challenges in some years Saturday, when the Raiders tangle with rugged Oregon College in Monmouth.

Coach Al Alkins' Red Raiders, resuming action after a one-week layoff rank as favorites based on past history, but they'll have to reckon with a pass defense that's allowed just 57 yards a game through three successful starts and has rifled opponents' aerial games for 11 interceptions in that period.

SOC has the tools to issue the supreme test in pinpoint passer Dan Miles and a flock of targets, led by Jim Calhoun who has already gathered in 20 for 150 yards and one touchdown. Miles piled up 548 yards through the air in his first two games.

OCE, also the loop leader in overall defense, gave an inkling of its possibilities last weekend at George Fox. The losing Quakers had only 42 yards total offense at halftime.

Much of the credit for the Wolves' defensive showing thus far would have to go to Dave Sturgis, who from his defensive halfback position intercepted four passes, returning one for a 45-yard touchdown against the Quakers. He also caught an 18-yard TD pass as an offensive end in that contest.

Sturgis' showing earned back of the week honors in the OCC, the line award going to Eastern Oregon's Mike Bech, who labored both ways in the Mounts' triumph over Oregon Tech. Other backfield nominees included Carl Smith, OTI; Bruce Ankeny, George Fox; and Bill Anderson, Eastern Oregon. Added the line list were Bob Hadlock, George Fox; Ken Lathen, OCE; and Nick Johnson, OTI.

LANEY, SORENSON LAUDED

Oregon College added another scalp to its collection this past weekend, when arch-rival Southern Oregon tumbled for the first time in eight years before the Wolves, 32-20.

But as much as that win meant to the Wolves' bid for the Oregon Collegiate Conference championship, this weekend's foe--Puget Sound--probably poses the biggest threat to the club's undefeated status.

Coach Bill McArthur's squad has won four straight this campaign, including three in conference play, and hold a string dating back to mid-1965 of 8-0. But Puget Sound is the same team, which leveled Eastern Washington earlier this year when the Savages were highly-ranked nationally.

Undefeated seasons aren't alien to McArthur. He's had two at OCE, one with the 1949 powerhouse that went 9-0 and another with the 1951 club that finished 6-0-1, the tie coming at Linfield, 6-6.

One of the big reasons for OCE's prominence this year has been the fine passing and quarterbacking in general of seniors Dave Laney and Ray Halter. It was Laney's turn to shine in the win over SOC, and his performance won back of the week honors.

Don Sorenson, Southern Oregon's offensive right tackle, was named lineman of the week. He was the key man ahead of SOC's running attack, which with an occasional pass enabled the Raiders to wipe away a 19-0 deficit and turn it into a 20-19 lead before OCE regrouped its forces.

Laney threw five touchdown passes, ranging from 11 to 53 yards, especially remarkable since he only threw 11 and completed 6. He fell just one scoring pass short of a past OCE great, Jim Bowlen, who tossed six in a game against Lower Columbia in 1957.

### OREGON COLLEGE WINS TITLE; SOUTHERN OREGON LEADS ASSAULT ON RECORDS

Oregon College ended Southern Oregon's stranglehold on the Oregon Collegiate Conference football pinnacle this year, riding a record-breaking defensive effort, a potent though late-developing running attack and a timely passing game to the title.

The Wolves rolled to a 6-2 season mark, 4-0 in the conference, losing its two games in muddy quagmires to Puget Sound, 16-6, and to Simon Fraser of Burnaby, B.C., 14-7, in the season finale.

But while OCE was making a lasting impression on OCC opponents, Southern Oregon's passing combination was making a shambles of the conference record book.

Dan Miles snapped two individual game marks, <sup>two</sup> ~~three~~ individual season standards and two individual career records. He also figured in two team game records and three team season marks.

His primary target, Jim Calhoun, snapped the one-game pass reception record and came within three catches of Spike Gordon's season reception figure, which was registered in one more game.

Rollin Schimmel of Eastern Oregon captured the rushing crown with 514 yards, 34 more than runnerup Ron Williams of Southern Oregon. Miles was far and away the best of the passers (172-274 for 1814 yards and 13 TDs), Calhoun led the receivers (67 catches, 700 yards, 6 TDs), Dave Sturgis of Oregon College topped the scoring (54 points) and Denny Ellis won another punting title (40.5 average on 32 punts).

For the defending co-champions of the Oregon Collegiate Conference, it's a crucial which obviously will have a big bearing on the outcome of the race for the flag.

And the afternoon battle at Monmouth is billed on the opening weekend of the 1968 conference season.

A night game at La Grande matching George Fox and Eastern Oregon completes Saturday's opening schedule.

In a non-counter, St. Mary's of Moraga, Calif., invades Klamath Falls to face Oregon Tech.

Willie Mills, OTI's speedster who rolled up 103 yards in his only game two weeks ago before being injured in practice, continues to lead conference rushing statistics while OCE's Bob Zeigler had 92 yards in two games.

SOC's Dave Barger has completed 24 of 65 passes for 306 yards and two touchdowns to hold his lead in passing statistics. Teammates Rod Rumrey (10 catches for 133 yards) and John Franzen (7 for 118) rank 1-2 in the receiving department.

Three players -- Barger of SOC and OCE's Dennis Sydow and Dave Rothwell -- share the scoring lead with 12 points while Steve Beecroft of George Fox leads punters with a 36.6 average on 17 boots.

Beecroft, George Fox quarterback, who is the No. 1 punter and No. 2 passer in the league, was named OCC Back of the Week for his play in the Quakers' 14-13 loss to the Seattle Cavaliers.

Offense tackle Steve Jacobson of OCE and SOC's pass-grabbing Rod Rumrey shared Lineman of the Week honors.

Other backs drawing mention were EOC's Len Phelan, Charles James of George Fox, OTI's Jay Hawkins and SOC's Craig Long and Clev Thompson. Other linemen nominated included Bob Corey of EOC, OCE's Tom Kosydar and Dennis Ankeny of George Fox.
