Fleming ^{Wins} Honorable Mention NAIA All-American Honor

Midfielder **Wade Fleming** (So., Lakeridge HS, Oregon City, Ore.) is the eighth NAIA All-American to come from George Fox University's men's soccer team since 1990.

He was named an NAIA honorable mention All-American. During the 1996 season, Fleming led the Bruins in scoring with 13 goals and contributed six assists.

His contributions helped propel George Fox to its 10th-consecutive winning season and to the NAIA Northwest Regional Tournament. The Bruins ended the season 11-10-1, runners-up in the Northwest Conference.

Fleming previously had been selected to the NAIA Pacific Northwest All-Region first team and the Northwest Conference first team.

Last season, Fleming received honorable mention from the Northwest Conference, the only freshman or sophomore to receive an award. He is a 1995 graduate of Lakeridge High School, where was a third-team 4A all-state selection.

Two other George Fox players were honored on the All-Pacific Northwest Region team. Goalkeeper **Curtis Selby** (So. Aloha HS, Ore.) earned second team honors after totalling eight shutouts and allowing just 1.3 goals a game. Winning all-region honorable mention were midfielder **Josh Turpen** (So., Sammamish HS, Bellevue, Wash.) (8 goals, 4 assists) and defender **Tommy Kolodge** (Aloha HS, Beaverton, Ore.).

Underclassmen Sweep George Fox Men's Soccer Team Awards

Underclassmen swept the George Fox men's soccer team awards announced recently at a spring awards ceremony. Midfielder **Wade Fleming (So., Lakeridge HS, Oregon City, Ore.)** received the Most Valuable Player and Best Offense Awards. Fleming led the Bruins in scoring with 13 goals and contributed six assists. He was named NAIA honorable mention All-American, first-team NAIA Pacific Northwest Region and first-team Northwest Conference.

Defender **Tommy Kolodge (So., Aloha HS, Beaverton, Ore.)** earned the Best Defense award. He played in every game and won All-Pacific Northwest Region honorable mention. Defender **Jeff Wells (So., Evergreen HS, Vancouver, Wash.)** was voted Most Inspirational, and fellow defender **Jonathan Williams (So., Mead HS, Wash.)** was named Most Improved. Williams moved up from the junior varsity team to become a varsity starter.

Rookie of the Year was awarded to **John Suchisa (Fr., Leilehua HS, Wahiawa, Hawaii)**. He had one goal and three assists.

The Bruins were the runners-up in the Northwest Conference, advancing to the NAIA Pacific Northwest Regional Tournament. They finished their 10th-consecutive winning season 11-10-1.

WHAT'S NOT BRUIN:

Concluding its 10th consecutive winning season, George Fox came within six minutes of upsetting No. 9 ranked Simon Fraser University in the NAIA Pacific Northwest Regional tournament, but fell 4-3 in sudden death overtime at the 140th-minute mark.

The youthful Bruins appear to have a bright future. George Fox will lose just one senior from its Northwest Conference runner-up team —forward **Justin Rivard (Bonanza HS, Las Vegas, Nev.)**. Just five members of George Fox's varsity squad were upperclassmen.

LAST WEEK:

George Fox 3, Simon Fraser 4 (2OT)

Unranked George Fox University had NAIA ninth-ranked Simon Fraser University on the ropes, but the short-handed Bruins couldn't hang on, falling 4-3 in sudden death overtime in the semifinal game of the NAIA Northwest Regional held Friday (Nov. 15) in Forest Grove, Ore. The Bruins played without the services of injured team captain and second-leading scorer **Josh Turpen (So., Sammamish HS, Bellevue, Wash.)**, who suffered a season-ending chest injury in the previous game.

After a scoreless first half, Simon Fraser jumped into the lead 36 seconds into the second half.

George Fox retaliated in the 58th minute, with midfielder **Joe Crown (So., Kent-Meridian HS, Kent, Wash.)** pounding in a goal from inches out, following a deflected shot by midfielder **Wade Fleming (So., Lakeridge HS, Oregon City, Ore.)**.

Forward **Justin Rivard (Sr., Bonanza HS, Las Vegas, Nev.)** broke the short-lived tie just one minute later, collecting a Fleming pass and punching it into the net at the 61-minute mark.

Simon Fraser forced overtime following a breakaway goal which evened the score 2-2 with 18 minutes remaining in regulation.

Bruin defender **Chad Pohlman (So., Shorecrest HS, Seattle, Wash.)** struck first in overtime, giving George Fox the 3-2 lead by heading in a corner kick from Crown in the 104th minute of play. Six minutes away from the end of the second overtime period, Simon Fraser evened the score 3-3, sending the game into sudden death overtime.

At the 140th minute of play, Simon Fraser put an end to the marathon match and advanced to the regional championship contest. The Clansmen defeated Seattle University Saturday, earning a berth to the NAIA national tournament.

CHAT WITH TSCHAN: (Comments from eighth-year head coach Manfred Tschan, 1993 NAIA District 2 and Area 1 Coach of the Year:

On NAIA PNW Regional vs. Simon Fraser: "They came out as strong and confident as you would expect and clearly dominated the first half. We were glad to get out of the half with a tie. After they scored first in the second half, there were two ways to go. A lot of times when you give up a goal like that it's really demoralizing, but we had the spirit and we weren't going to give it up yet. Our guys showed that winning and losing are not always determined by skill. We came back with two goals and set them on their heels. We had a couple of scoring chances after that which could have put them away. The fact that we came back strong I think reinforced the fears they have of playing us."

"Those last two goals they scored were gifts. For the last 10 minutes they had been sending high balls into the box and (George Fox goalkeeper) Curtis Selby had been going out and grabbing them. We totally knew what they were doing, we totally controlled them, and then the next thing I knew one of their midfielders had the ball all alone."

George Fox Makes Second-Ever NAIA Regional Playoff Appearance

George Fox earned one of two at-large berths to the NAIA Pacific Northwest Regional playoffs Friday-Saturday (Nov. 15-16), hosted by Pacific University in Forest Grove, Ore. The Bruins earned the berth on the basis of their runner-up finish in the Northwest Conference of Independent Colleges Tournament Nov. 9-10. No. 3 seed George Fox will face Pacific Northwest Athletic Conference champion and No. 2 seed Simon Fraser University — the No. 9 ranked team in the NAIA national poll — Friday at 1 p.m. The other semifinal match will pit No. 1 seed Pacific University versus No. 4 seed Seattle University. The championship game will be played at 1 p.m. on Sunday, winner advancing to the national tournament in Birmingham, Ala.

The last and only other NAIA regional playoff appearance for George Fox came in 1993 after the Bruins won the NAIA District 2 championship. George Fox defeated Simon Fraser 2-0 in overtime to advance to the NAIA national tournament.

The at-large berth is a first for George Fox. Unlike in recent years, the NAIA's Longo Rating System for determining the strength of a team's season results was not used to determine the at-large berths. Despite having the best record and national ranking in the region, George Fox's 1994 (15-3) and 1995 (16-5) teams were passed over for at-large berths.

George Fox 4, Puget Sound 0

George Fox avenged two regular season losses by shutting out University of Puget Sound 4-0 Saturday (Nov. 9) in the Northwest Conference semifinal in Forest Grove, Ore.

The shutout was the fourth in six games for the Bruins and kept them undefeated (6-0) in NAIA district and conference semifinal playoff games.

Midfielder **Wade Fleming** (So., Lakeridge HS, Oregon City, Ore.) got the scoring started 17 minutes into the first half. Taking a cross from forward **Justin Rivard** (Sr., Bonanza HS, Las Vegas, Nev.), Fleming got behind the Logger defense and beat the keeper one-on-one.

Two minutes later, Rivard again set up midfielder **Ryan Gwaltney** (Jr., Roseburg HS, Ore.) with another one-on-one with the keeper.

Fleming scored his second before the half, finding the net at the 27-minute mark, following an deflected cross from **John Williams** (So., Mead HS, Spokane).

Josh Turpen (So., Sammamish HS, Bellevue, Wash.) punched in the final Bruin goal midway through the second half. Following up on a rebound from his own deflected penalty kick, Turpen slammed the ball home from five feet out.

The shutout was the eighth of the season for Bruin goalkeeper **Curtis Selby (So., Aloha HS, Beaverton, Ore.)**. He had 12 saves.

CHAT WITH TSCHAN: (Comments from eighth-year head coach Manfred Tschan, 1993 NAIA District 2 and Area 1 Coach of the Year:

On NCIC Semifinal vs. Puget Sound: "It was our best effort of the year. We were very focused on playing hard and playing well. We did a good job of finishing opportunities and creating opportunities. We moved the ball so quickly that (their defense) couldn't step up in time."

On NCIC Final vs. Pacific: "We showed Saturday our potential, and we showed Sunday how frustrating we can make it for ourselves by playing poorly. We played very few early balls, and if we did, they weren't very high quality. They have some trouble clearing the ball, but it didn't matter because we didn't have much movement in their box. Guys who had been moving the ball Saturday were carrying it, holding it, and not passing it. It's frustrating."

On Simon Fraser: "Year in year and year out they are probably the top team in the Northwest. They've been ranked as high as second (in the NAIA) this year. We obviously have our work cut out for us, but on the flip side of the coin, We're 2-0 against them. They are beatable, but we'll have to play very well against them. If we can pull it off, we need to make sure that we play smart the next day. It's truly 'one-and-out' from here or out."

CHAT WITH TSCHAN: (Comments from eighth-year head coach Manfred Tschan, 1993 NAIA District 2 and Area 1 Coach of the Year:

On Western Baptist: "We tried to get off to a quick start and that's how it looked in the scorebook, but I was not happy with how we started defensively. We wanted to play 45 minutes of good, hard, playoff-type soccer and then experiment with our lineup, which we did. CHAT WITH TSCHAN: (Comments from eighth-year head coach Manfred Tschan, 1993 NAIA District 2 and Area 1 Coach of the Year)"

On UPS: "It was pretty good game, one we had well in hand. It was just a matter of making a few plays and running the clock out. They didn't look like they were changing any momentum or anything. It ended up that in the last five minutes we gave them two gift-wrapped goals because our players were more interested in scoring than making sure the other team didn't score a goal. We got caught short-handed and you can't do that when you have the lead."

On PLU: "We started slow, but we picked it up and started to play our game. We started to dominate, but then it was just a parade of errors again. We made more than they did or they took more advantage of them. In the last 15 minutes of regulation, we had about four good scoring chances to win. Instead, we went to overtime."

On Pacific: "It's going to be tough. We played them really well in stretches over there. We had opportunities, but did a horrible job of defending set plays. Both goalkeepers had nightmare games sitting back there being targets. The good news is that we learned a lot of things to do differently this time."

Whitworth: "It's going to be a tough game. They have been lot more consistent than we have. Some of their wins have been impressive, like sweeping Linfield."

On Linfield: "Against Linfield our play went from inconsistent to downright ugly. CHAT WITH TSCHAN: (Comments from eighth-year head coach Manfred Tschan, 1993 NAIA District 2 and Area 1 Coach of the Year)

On Concordia: "We treated the game as preseason, which it was. We had our game plan and our substitution pattern predetermined regardless of the score. When they scored late in the game we had some strange (personnel) combinations on the field and were playing high pressure just to work it. We got caught."

On Pacific Lutheran: "It was good to get that first conference win and win the home opener. The fact that it was PLU made it a little sweeter. We had a chance to make amends this year. We played very well as a team, and **Curtis Selby** showed he was fully healthy again. He not only dominated the box, but his kicking game was on. He deserved a shutout, but the whole defense played great. We showed some room for improvement at the very end when they started pressuring us."

On Puget Sound: "They are a solid team, but it was a hard one to take. We were at least evenly matched. We wasted a lot of good opportunities by not being aggressive enough, and not being disciplined in some cases. We didn't finish our runs. They presented us with all kinds of gifts that we rejected. It's probably one of those cases where a lot of our guys are going to bed thinking there are a lot of things they could have done better."

On Whitman: "They don't have a lot of new players, but they do have a new coach. They were a pretty skillful club last year. We're possibly a little less athletic. It won't be a lop-sided game."

On Whitworth: "Spokane is a very tough place to win games, and they are probably the tougher of the two teams. They were in the playoffs the last year and they were young. Their new coach took Evergreen State to regionals last year."

George Fox University 1996 Men's Soccer Outlook

Eighth-year head coach Manfred Tschan is hoping young talent and a change of strategy will be enough for George Fox's men's soccer team to defend its Northwest Conference title.

Repeating as champion — or even just earning George Fox's seventh-consecutive NAIA playoff appearance — won't be a simple task. At the end of the 1995 season, George Fox had two senior All-Americans and five of the top 17 scorers in the conference. None return for the 1996 campaign. The youthful Bruin roster lists just one senior and four juniors.

Tschan — whose teams have never finished below second in their conference or district — has a history of turning young, inexperienced teams into winners.

"This is one of my youngest teams ever," said Tschan. "We have only one senior. The last time that happened (in 1993), we went to nationals. That was a team like this; not much experience, one senior on the varsity, and we had changed our style dramatically. You never know."

Tschan plans to adapt his team style of play to fit the quality of players now on the roster, many who brought all-state credentials from high school.

"In terms of soccer skill, this is one of the most skilled teams we've ever had," said Tschan. "We want to take advantage of that. We're going to make a radical change from the high-pressure, fast-paced, attacking style we've been playing. It will take a little more patience and a lot more reading of situations and the intentions of teammates and opponents. We're going to give our skillful players much more opportunity to express themselves and show their stuff."

Josh Turpen (So., Sammamish HS, Bellevue, Wash.) and all-conference honorable mention **Wade Fleming** (So., Lakeridge HS, Oregon City) are talented center midfielders who should enjoy the new system.

"The two guys in the midfield are as good as we've ever had in the program," said Tschan. "They're a couple of great playmaker types. We're counting on them making a lot

of good decisions and contributing heavily in the scoring column"

He's still deciding who will play the outside midfield positions.

"We're looking to replace (Honorable Mention All-American) Ian Reschke and there are only so many guys that look like they fit the bill," said Tschan.

Erik Sorensen (Jr., Bothell HS, Wash.) and **Travis Johnson (Jr., Hidden Valley HS, Grants Pass, Ore.)** have varsity collegiate experience. Other choices could be **Michael Moody (So., Inglemoor HS, Bothell, Wash.)**, one of the freshman or a converted defender.

Up front, the Bruins have to replace their top five scorers. **Joe Crown (So., Kent-Meridian HS, Kent, Wash.)** and **Justin Rivard (Sr., Bonanza HS, Las Vegas, Nev.)** are the only returning strikers, but Tschan says several of the freshmen have looked good in preseason.

Four freshmen likely will see time up front. **Allen Bullock (Fr., Roseburg HS, Ore.)** and **Jared Pearson (Fr., Bend HS, Sunriver, Ore.)** both bring 1995 Oregon 4A all-state honorable mention honors. **John Suehisa (Fr., Leilehua HS, Wahiawa, Hawaii)** was his high school team and league MVP and **Aaron Elling (Fr., Lander Valley HS, Lander, Wyo.)** was named to the Wyoming all-state team.

Tschan expects defense should continue to be a team strength. The Bruins have recorded 32 shutouts over the last three seasons. Anchoring the defense will likely be an all-state tandem from Aloha High School: goalkeeper **Curtis Selby (So., Aloha HS, Beaverton Ore.)** and sweeper **Tommy Kolodge (So., Aloha HS, Beaverton Ore.)**.

Also seeing time in the box will be goalkeeper **Chris Wood (So., Bothell HS, Wash.)**.

Tschan can call on three defenders who played man-marker last season: **Jeff Wells (So., Evergreen HS, Ridgefield, Wash.)**, **Ryan Gwaltney (Jr., Roseburg HS, Ore.)** and **Chad Pohlman (So., Shorecrest HS, Seattle, Wash.)**. New additions in the back will be Navy veteran **Scott Gordon (Jr., Olympic HS, Bremerton, Wash.)** and **Kris Sorensen (Fr., Bothell HS, Wash.)**, brother of Erik Sorensen.
