

This program is designed to help the Christian family grow and relate more meaningfully as a unit, in light of the pressures being brought to bear upon the American family. Four to six family units come together for a weekend of good experiences.

The program is built around the following objectives--to have fun: games, singing, boating. To share those things which make the family "click", i.e., hobbies and family fun times, how problems are solved, how Christ is shared within the family, needed areas of growth. To study the Bible's view of the family. To worship together. To experience communication between family members. Family retreats open doors of commitment and care, concern, and cooperation among family members and between families.

Tilikum has a quiet out-of-the-way setting in the Chehalem Valley--45 minutes from Portland and Salem. There are 75 acres of woods and meadows for rambling, and 15-acre lake for canoeing and fishing. At Illahee House, our small group retreat building, we specialize in offering a warm atmosphere, excellent food, recreational opportunities and creative programming with a focus on relational Bible study--all the elements for a meaningful retreat experience.

These retreats begin at 7:30 p.m. Friday and end right after Sunday noon dinner.

Bring your own sleeping bag or bedding. Six people or one family to a room.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Highway 99W to Newberg

2. Turn North at intersection of 99W and Hwy. 240 (Chehalem Valley sign)

3. Follow Hwy. 240 for 5 miles

4. Turn right (N) leaving 240 at the Gaston/Laurelwood sign

5. Bear left at junction

6. Watch for Camp Tilikum sign about one mile.
