Dear Mr. Lombard--

Let me thank you for your letter of the 1st. in reply to my inquiries concerning your organization.

I am not sure that I understand your statement, "We handle material relief in clothing only." Does that mean that you do not distribute food among the needy peoples of Europe? Is money that is contributed to your organization used only for clothing (aside from what is taken by overhead)?

Newberg has had half a dozen clothing drives and possibly more in the last two years. Many of our people are more interested in food distribution.

With the knowledge that all the help sent by all the agencies will not relieve all the suffering in Europe, we are more interested in the amount of relief sent than in the means of its distribution, though the efficiency of this distribution is of course an important factor.
