OCE'S ZEIGLER WINS 2 TITLES, INCLUDING 2ND STRAIGHT RUSHING CROWN

Oregon College's junior running star, Bob Zeigler, survived a final -game bid by Dave Barger of Southern Oregon to win the Oregon Collegiate Conference scoring championship.

The title was the second claimed by Zeigler. He earlier wrapped up his second consecutive rushing crown by beating out teammate Dennis Sydow.

Zeigler won the scoring laurels with 54 points. Barger, who scored 14 of SOC's total in a season-ending 38-31 victory over 1967 NAIA runnerup Eastern Washington, was second with 50.

Barger won the passing title, completing 151 of 290 attempts for an accurate 52.1 per cent, 2,050 yards and 15 touchdowns.

His SOC teammate, Rod Rumsey, won the pass receiving crown with 55 catches good for 681 yards and 3 TDs. Ray Patrick of EOC had more pass receiving yardage, however, with 813. John Franzen of SOC shared the title with Rumsey a year ago but was third with 33 catches this season.

Steve Beecroft of George Fox captured the punting honors, averaging 37.8 yards on 44 boots.

Southern Oregon, averaging 323.4 yards per game, won team total offense honors while league champion Oregon College dominated total defense honors, although EOC posted the best passing defense average (112.6 yards per game).

Three individual and four team records went into the books:

#### INDIVIDUAL GAME

Passing -- 427 yards, Stan Weiper, EOC (30 completions, 54 attempts, 4 interceptions) against Boise College.

Passes attempted -- 54, Stan Weiper, EOC (30 completions, 4 interceptions, 427 yards) against Boise College.

#### INDIVIDUAL SEASON

Passes attempted -- 290, Dave Barger, SOC (10 games).

#### TEAM GAME

Passing -- 510 yards, SOC (20-37) against George Fox.

Touchdown passes -- 6, SOC, 1964 against Moffett AFB and 1968, against George Fox, and also by OCE, 1957, against Lower Columbia JC.

Poorest pass defense -- 505 yards, George Fox, (19-35) against Southern Oregon

For the defending co-champions of the Oregon Collegiate Conference, it's a crucial which obviously will have a big bearing on the outcome of the race for the flag.

And the afternoon battle at Monmouth is billed on the opening weekend of the 1968 conference season.

A night game at La Grande matching George Fox and Eastern Oregon completes Saturday's opening schedule.

In a non-counter, St. Mary's of Moraga, Calif., invades Klamath Falls to face Oregon Tech.

Willie Mills, OTI's speedster who rolled up 103 yards in his only game two weeks ago before being injured in practice, continues to lead conference rushing statistics while OCE's Bob Zeigler had 92 yards in two games.

SOC's Dave Barger has completed 24 of 65 passes for 306 yards and two touchdowns to hold his lead in passing statistics. Teammates Rod Rumrey (10 catches for 133 yards) and John Franzen (7 for 118) rank 1-2 in the receiving department.

Three players -- Barger of SOC and OCE's Dennis Sydow and Dave Rothwell -- share the scoring lead with 12 points while Steve Beecroft of George Fox leads punters with a 36.6 average on 17 boots.

Beecroft, George Fox quarterback, who is the No. 1 punter and No. 2 passer in the league, was named OCC Back of the Week for his play in the Quakers' 14-13 loss to the Seattle Cavaliers.

Offense tackle Steve Jacobson of OCE and SOC's pass-grabbing Rod Rumrey shared Lineman of the Week honors.

#### WOLVES' TOUTED DEFENSE FACES MVC POWER LINFIELD SATURDAY

Oregon College's renown defense, which held southern Oregon to a minus 26 yards on the ground last weekend, will face a stern test against Northwest Conference power Linfield Saturday night.

The inter-league battle will be waged under the lights at McMinnville.

Eastern Oregon, meanwhile, will resume Oregon Collegiate Conference play with a Saturday night engagement with southern Oregon at Ashland. EOC also opened its league action last weekend with an impressive 33-7 victory over George Fox.

Oregon Tech, only a 20-14 loser to St. Mary's of Moraga, Calif., plays George Fox at Newberg in an afternoon conference test.

Gordon Syphers, a 156-pound sophomore halfback from EOC, was named Back of the Week. Filling in for the injured Don Luisi, Syphers sparked the Mounties' romp over George Fox by scoring twice -- once on a 58-yard punt return on the fourth play of the game. He gained 70 yards on 17 carries and had two other TD runs called back -- one a 59-yard effort.

Another back who rated high was OCE's Bob Zeigler, who gained 84 yards on 20 carries in the Wolves' big win over SOC, caught one pass for 35 yards and intercepted another pass while enjoying a good day on defense.

Also nominated was Byron Debban of George Fox, who gained 81 yards on 13 carries against EOC.

Eastern Oregon also collected Lineman of the Week honors in Ray Patrick. The split end grabbed six passes for 84 yards against George Fox -- including one diving, one-handed catch of a 55-yard aerial from Mountie quarterback Stan Weiper.

Other nominations included SOC end John Franzen, who caught five passes for 74 yards, Gordy Findy of George Fox and SOC line-backer Cleve Thompson, who was in on 17 tackles against OCE.

#### WOLVES MATCH DEFENSE AGAINST MOUNTIES' OFFENSE

Oregon College, still sporting the best defense in the Oregon Collegiate Conference despite the 16-0 loss to Linfield in a non-counter last weekend, will take on the highest scoring Eastern Oregon football team in years in one of two featured conference games this Saturday.

The night contest between the Wolves (1-0) and EOC (1-1), which has piled up 91 points in four games, is scheduled at La Grande.

Southern Oregon, which shared the OCC crown with OCE a year ago, but already has one conference defeat this year -- to OCE -- battles arch-rival Oregon Tech in an afternoon game at Klamath Falls.

George Fox, winless in four appearances and 0-2 in OCC action, steps out of league competition to face Azusa Pacific in California.

New leaders emerged in three of the OCC's five individual statistical departments.

They include:

Vic Livingston, Oregon Tech, who enjoyed a 130-yard performance against George Fox to move past OCE's Bob Zeigler into the rushing lead with 250 yards and a 4.9 average.

Gary Chapman, also of OTI, who snagged three passes for 134 yards to vault over six other players and into the pass receiving lead with 10 catches for 223 yards. SOC's Rod Rumrey has the most receptions, however, with 17.

And SOC's Dick Orr, who scored three touchdowns against Eastern Oregon and now shares the conference point lead with Charles James of George Fox. Both had three TDs for 18 points. Both moved past SOC's Dave Barger, who is now third with 17 points.

Barger, however, still sets the passing pace, completing 57 of 121 for 688 yards and five TDs, although his nine interceptions also leads the league.

Top punter continues to be Dennis Sydow of OCE with a 36-yard average on 12 boots although Steve Beecroft of George Fox has a 35.6 mark with three of his 29 punts being blocked.

OTI's Chapman, a split end, also scored one of the Owls' three TDs against George Fox, added two extra points and also booted a 31-yard field goal in the final three seconds to earn Back of the Week honors. Jon Lamoreaux, OCE's defense tackle who may switch to offense this week, collected 12 tackles against Linfield and shared Lineman of the Week honors with SOC's Craig Johnson, who caught two TD passes and all five of his receptions (for 127 yards) came in the first half.

### WOLVES HUNT TIE FOR TITLE; HOPEFUL RAIDERS 1ST TO END OCC SEASON

Oregon College can clinch a tie for the Oregon Collegiate Conference football title this weekend.

The unbeaten (2-0) Wolves take on Oregon Tech (1-1) in a Saturday afternoon battle at Monmouth.

The Wolves own a win over Southern Oregon (2-1), which is the only team -- other than OTI -- which has a chance to beat out OCE in the title chase.

SOC's Red Raiders will close out their conference schedule at home in Ashland in an afternoon game against winless George Fox. Eastern Oregon, meanwhile, steps out of counting play for a night contest at Boise (Idaho) College.

OTI is 1-1 with one OCC game remaining after Saturday -- against EOC next weekend -- while in the other OCC finale next weekend OCE finishes up at George Fox.

In games through last weekend, OTI's Vic Livingston (rushing) and Gary Chapman (receiving), and SOC's Dave Barger (passing) held onto their individual conference statistical leads.

But three new faces emerged atop the scoring race and a new one on top of the punter's list. Dennis Sydow of OCE and SOC teammates Rod Rumrey and Dave Barger all have scored 24 points in five games to share the scoring lead. New leader among punters is Steve Beecroft of George Fox, who regained the top spot after a two-week absence. He has averaged 36.7 yards on 36 boots.

OCE's Sydow and Dick Orr of SOC were named co-winners of the Back of the Week award. Sydow nearly doubled his season rushing total with a 110-yard effort on 17 carries for two touchdowns in the Wolves' win at EOC. Orr had runs of 34 and 30 yards and a game total of 80 on only six carries plus three pass receptions for 91 yards -- including one for 71 yards and a TD -- as SOC outscored OTI.

Lineman of the week honors went to Terry Lesch, an OCE linebacker. He twice tossed the EOC quarterback for losses totaling 24 yards and also recovered a fumble.

Other backs nominated included defense back Bill Bailey of OCE and Bill Jackson of George Fox, while other linemen nominated included Don Towny of SOC, OTI's Chapman and Randy Casey of George Fox.

### OCE WOLVES AGAIN REIGN AS OCC CHAMPIONS

Bill McArthur and the Oregon College Wolves again rule the Oregon Collegiate Conference.

McArthur guided the Wolfpack to their second clear-cut conference football crown in the past three years with a 21-0 OCC season-ending victory over George Fox last weekend.

And it was fitting that OCE, the leading defensive club in the league, would clinch the title with a shutout--the only one recorded by the league's five teams in counting action this season.

Oregon Tech won the battle for third place with its biggest offense explosion of the season in a 49-14 win over Eastern Oregon.

Southern Oregon, which finished up its conference season a week earlier and finished second with a 3-1 record after sharing the title with OCE last year, dropped a 33-19 contest to St. Mary's in California.

The Red Raiders will finish up their 10-game schedule with three more non-counters, beginning at University of San Francisco Saturday afternoon.

Other weekend non-counters include George Fox at Pacific in a night game at Forest Grove and Oregon College at University of British Columbia.

EOC, Oregon Tech and OCE will end their seasons the following weekend.

Three of the individual statistic categories sport new leaders again this week.

Bob Zeigler of OCE slipped past OTI's Vic Levingston into the rushing lead with a 113-yard day against George Fox. The Wolves' back now has gained 458 yards to Levingston's 390 after the latter picked up only 29 in the Owls' easy win over EOC.

SOC's Dave Barger regained the passing lead from Stan Weiper of Eastern. The Red Raider quarterback, despite falling below his season average with 191 yards through the air against St. Mary's, now has 1,341 yards. Weiper, limited to only 5 completions for 52 yards against OTI, trails by only 31 yards, however. Barger has one more completion than Weiper, 95-94, and leads in TD passes, 11-9. Both have completed 49 per cent of their pass attempts.

Barger and OTI's Gary Chapman and Dennis Sydow of OCE all share the scoring lead with 36 points. Two different players shared the lead last week.

Sydow was named back of the week after he gained 119 yards rushing against George Fox. He also passed for 48 yards, caught 3 passes and scored two of the Wolves' 3 TDs in the title-clincher.

Lineman of the week honors went to Larry Craven of George Fox, who was in on 27 tackles against OCE.

Other backs nominated included Stan Thomas of SOC, Phil Jones of GF and Fred Keiser of OTI. Other linemen nominees included EOC's Chuck Berry, John Tubbs of OTI, OCE's Pat Walsh, Gary Findley of GF and SOC's Red Dummer.

# WOLVES' ZEIGLER CLOSES IN ON TWO OCC STATISTICAL TITLES

Bob Zeigler of Oregon College didn't set any records when he scored four touchdowns last weekend, but it did win earn the Wolves' ace the conference Back of the Week award.

Zeigler ran for three touchdowns and scored another on a pass play as OCE ran its season record to 6-2 with a 42-7 romp over British Columbia. He finished with 87 yards rushing on 15 carries and caught three passes for 72 yards.

And Zeigler, with one game remaining in the season, stands a good chance to walking off with a pair of individual statistical titles in OCC play.

He currently leads teammate Dennis Sydow, who is in second place, by 54 yards in the race for the conference rushing title. Zeigler has gained 545 yards to Sydow's 491. Both have scored five TDs rushing.

And the four-TD outburst against UBC also moved Zeigler into the scoring lead. He has 54 points on 9 touchdowns. Again, Sydow is his nearest competitor -- along with SOC's Dave Barger and Gary Chapman of OTI -- all of whom have 36 points.

Barger, who has one more game remaining after this weekend, continues to set the pace in the passing department, although Stan Welper of Eastern Oregon was hanging tough heading into last weekend's final Mountie game -- which isn't included in this week's statistical report.

Red Rumrey of SOC regained the pass receiving lead from EOC's Ray Patrick. Rumrey has 43 for 569 yards while Patrick had 40 catches prior to last weekend.

Jon Lamoreaux, Zeigler's OCE teammate, claimed Lineman of the Week honors after he was in on 18 tackles from the defensive guard position in the easy win at Vancouver, B.C.

Other linemen nominated included Dave Tyre of SOC and Tom Mason of George Fox. New George Fox quarterback Dennis Ankeny, who completed 11 of 18 passes in a 16-0 loss to Pacific University, also was nominated for Back of the Week.
