GEORGE FOX BASEBALL COACH



PAT BAILEY

In just five short years, Pat Bailey, the 2000 Northwest Conference Coach of the Year, has established himself as one of the brightest new stars in the college coaching ranks.

With five straight winning records of 25-16, 29-14, 25-13, 32-8, and last year's 31-10, Bailey has a career record of 142-61, a .700 winning percentage, the best of anyone ever to coach the Bruins and a mark that ranks 14th among active coaches in Division III with five or more years' experience. His teams were Northwest Conference runner-ups in 1996 and 1998, conference champions in 1997, co-champions in 1999, and last season won a second conference title under Bailey, advancing to the NCAA Division III West Regional in their first year of NCAA eligibility.

In 1997, Bailey was named Northwest Conference Coach of the Year after guiding the Bruins to their eighth conference or district title in a 10-year span. In 1999, he was Co-Conference Coach of the Year with

Linfield College's Scott Carnahan as the two rivals shared the league crown.

Several of Bailey's players have received all-conference and/or all-district recognition, including six members of last year's team. In 1999, first baseman Nate Barnett became his first NAIA First Team All-American, and last year, staff ace Ryan Alvis was named to the NCAA All-America Third Team.

Bailey took over the Bruin program immediately after guiding West Linn High School into the Oregon Class 4A state championship game. At West Linn, his teams advanced to the Class 4A state playoffs seven times, and in his final season were edged 2-1 in the 1995 state championship game.

Four times Bailey was named Three Rivers League Coach of the Year. He was at West Linn for 10 years as head baseball coach and assistant football coach. His baseball teams won five league titles and reached the Oregon semifinals in 1989, 1991 and 1995. From 1989 to 1995, his combined record as a high school and American Legion baseball coach was 315-105 (.750).

Prior to West Linn, Bailey taught and coached at Willamette High School in Eugene, Ore., for three years. He has worked

at various baseball camps, and served as a pitching coach at the University of Portland in 1992.

Bailey is a 1974 graduate of Moscow High School in Idaho, where he played football, basketball and was the baseball team's MVP. He earned two letters in baseball at North Idaho College in Couer d'Alene, Idaho, then two more as a starting outfielder and team captain during his senior season at the University of Idaho. He continued playing semiprofessionally until age 28.

In 1978, Bailey completed his business education degree, and earned a master of education degree in educational administration from the University of Oregon in 1983.

At George Fox, Bailey is also associate director of athletics, chair of the school's Sports Hall of Fame Committee, and a teacher in the department of health and human services.

Bailey and his wife, Susan, live in Newberg with their children, Alex, 17, and Ann, 14.

***** Sophomore Sensation**

Eric Bell has jumped onto the Bruin single-season charts in several categories during an outstanding sophomore season, his first in a George Fox uniform. His 15 doubles are tied for the 8th-best single-season total in history, while his 9 home runs rank as the 11th-best total.

***** Who's the Boss?**

Glenn Boss made his 22nd pitching appearance and recorded his 6th save of the season in the Bruins' 4-3 win over Linfield on Apr. 23, extending his own individual records in those categories set this year. The old appearances record was 17, held by Vincent DeJoia (1991), Will Clark (1995), Paul Andrewjeski (1999), and Mike Shear (1999). The previous saves record of 4 was held by Tom Bohlman (1993), Ryan Muñoz (1997), Eric Beasley (1998), and Brody Wilson (2000).

***** Rack 'Em Up!**

Paul Andrewjeski has 63 strikeouts in 60.1 innings, an average of 9.40 whiffs per nine innings. That mark would be No. 2 on the Bruin single-season list to the 10.53 K's per nine by Mark Andersen in 1994. His total of 63 strikeouts currently ranks 8th in on the single-season list.

***** Location, Location, Location!**

Brody Wilson has walked only 9 batters in 57.2 innings, an average of 1.40 walks per nine innings, which would rank as 3rd-best all-time if he can maintain that pace. The top two are Kess Romano (1.14 in 2000) and Nate Barnett (1.31 in 1998).

***** They Kept Comin' Back for More!**

In the Bruins' 14-12, 12-inning win at Linfield that took 4:20 to play on Apr. 21, Aaron Bliss, Greg Dombek, Kyle Langeliers, Ryan Dearing, and Ryan Brown all tied a Bruin record held by Adam Kershaw (1994), Nate Barnett (1997), Ryan Munoz (1997), and Mark Tyler (1997) by batting officially 7 times in the game. Bliss was 5-for-7, falling one hit short of the Bruin record of 6 hits in a game by Munoz and Tyler vs. Puget Sound (4/26/97).

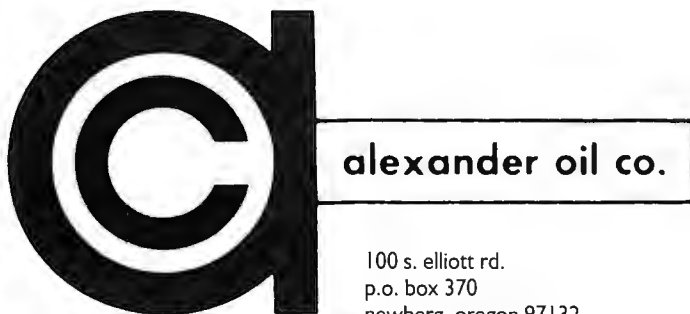
