Classes held in the Friends Training School Building in Kotzebue

SP/285 - PRINCIPLES OF COMMUNICATION - 2 hours

The class meets daily 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. for in-depth study of sermon preparation and delivery for pastors, and fundamentals of speech communication for laymen. Attention given to effective methods of teaching for Sunday School teachers.

REL/285 - PRINCIPLES OF CHURCH ADMINISTRATION

Class meets daily 1:30 to 4:00 p.m. for study of methods of pastoral work, church organization and structure, techniques of pastoral psychology and counseling, and analysis of principles of leadership.

REL/285 - THEOLOGY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT - 2 hours

The class meets Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings 7:00 to 9:30 p.m. for in-depth study of Trinitarian doctrine in relation to the church and personal religious experience. Special attention given to an objective non-sectarian study of the Scriptural gifts of the Spirit and the modern charismatic movement.
