Dear Friend:

Thank you very much for your interest in the ministry of the Four Flats Quartet. It is our hope that this letter may be a guide to plans for our appearance before your group.

Our financial arrangements are as follows: If at all possible we desire to receive a separate free-will offering. Every cent received above our expenses will be used to help defray the costs of our ministry in high school assemblies and Bible Clubs. Ordinarily, when we go with a Christian purpose into a high school, it is at our own expense. With our other obligations the expenses of this work cannot be taken out of our own pockets, so we are asking that other Christian people share in this witness.
