Dear Phil,

As you know, the Lilly Endowment did not renew the Kotzebue grant. We are, consequently, struggling for ways to maintain the Kotzebue Center, even if on a limited basis, for the coming year. The Perishos and others in Alaska feel strongly that this must be done.

Because of the lack of funds, Roy has taken the pastorate of the near-by West Chehalem Friends Church, with the understanding that the church will release him to the college for such programs as are needed.

During my visit to California Yearly Meeting, I reported on the need of \$2500 to keep the program going for this next year. In conversation with Keith Sarver, he suggested that I share this need with you.

Would you be interested in underwriting the budget for this next year? This may be beyond your ability but I felt led to lay this burden before you. We have applied to some other foundations for help but I do not believe that these funds would be available, if granted, until next fiscal year.

I imagine that you are having a busy summer. We would surely love to see you whenever you are in the area.
