**TODAY'S GAME:** The Bruins close out the regular season with a bid to solidify their hold on second place in the conference. George Fox and Linfield are tied, but the Bruins beat the Wildcats twice in head-to-head matchups ... The Bruins lead the series with the Boxers 15-13 after taking a 1-0 win on Jesse Johnson's goal in Forest Grove on Sept. 19 ... Pacific started the year 3-0, then went 1-8-2, but the Boxers are coming off wins of 1-0 over Whitworth and 2-1 over Whitman, both in overtime ... The Bruins will honor four seniors prior to the game: Bryan Erickson, Adam Moore, Merrick Brownlee, and Nigel Hunter ... Erickson is 6th all-time at GFU with 34 career goals, 5th in assists with 28, and 6th in points with 96 ... Brownlee stands 8th all-time in goals with 29, 7th in assists with 24, 9th in points with 82, and has tied the single-season assists record with 12.
