Dear Chris,

We got another statement from Sacred Records showing us that we had \$29.92 royalty money coming from them for records they sold during the month of May. They are just putting that on our account since we owe them quite a bit on more records we have purchased for use on this summer's trip. So we are sending you your fourth out of our treasury by this money order. Don't suppose you need it but we didn't want the dirty stuff laying around here.

We've just been listening to Kenneth Goff (the converted Communist) on the radio from Norfolk, about 40 miles from here. Our wives went to hear him last night. He said stuff over the air that it seemed like any of the 4-500 Communists he spoke of in Nebraska--he named the leaders--would kill him for if they could. We were talking of the sin in America with Lowell Roberts last night, morals etc., and Lowell says there was no sin in Sodom and Gomorrah that America is not guilty of, and Goff helps us to see how America might be destroyed as Sodom and Gomorrah were destroyed.

Chris, we need an idea from you as to your attitude toward the quartet in your future. I don't mean to influence your attitude at all. We just want to know how you feel right now. Here's the deal. Paul is definitely contracted to teach again next school yr. If Dick were going to go back to teaching after this summer he would have had to get some schooling this summer instead of going with us. He could have gotten in on the G.I. bill and human reason would say he was a fool for going with us, and many humans have told him that. But he felt definitely that it was God's will for him to go with us, giving up the possible \$2000 or more. Now Dick doesn't have anything certain to go into at the end of the summer and all of us are open to the possibility that God might open the way for us to do something for Him as a quartet this next school year. Now we will probably see the open door if there is to be one, while we are at Winona. But we would have better idea how to answer if we knew whether or not something like this is in your thinking at all or not. We realize that with two of you fathers of two, we would not expect a job that would keep us away from home much. A television, or radio job, or something comparable is in our thinking. Something around home. I would like to be able to go to school on the side, but I doubt if a thing like that would be possible.

Could you give us some idea of your response to this poorly written letter so that we could have it at Winona Lake. Write so we will get it here before July 1, or send

We will get there July 7.

We've been having some good meetings. None at the alters yet though. We need more prayer. We go into Souix City tonight to sing in the Jach Shuler revival meeting. Stewart Hamblin will be there.
