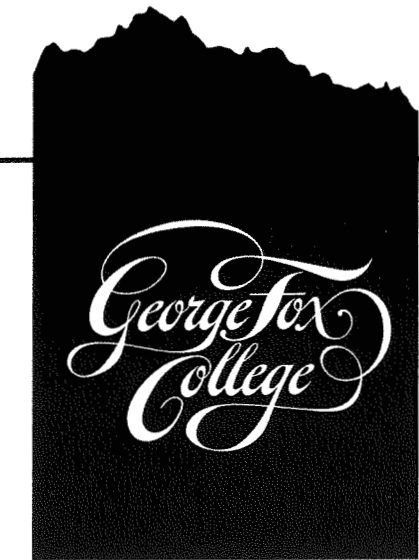

George Fox College, in its 105th year, is one of America's Best Colleges. Eight times it has been given that designation by *U.S. News & World Report* magazine. In 1995 GFC was ranked second in academic reputation among Western Regional Liberal Arts Colleges, including colleges and universities from Texas to Hawaii. The magazine also named George Fox to its list of "Top Teaching Schools," second among liberal arts colleges in the western region.

George Fox is one of the nation's fastest-growing colleges. Enrollment more than tripled from 549 in 1986 to 1,717 in the fall of 1995.

The College offers unique programs to its students. Every incoming freshman is given a Macintosh computer to use and keep upon graduation. When students reach their third year at GFC, they are eligible for the Juniors Abroad program, where the College pays transportation costs for a three-week overseas study tour.

GFC students come from 32 states, one U.S. territory and nine nations. More than 40 religious denominations are represented on campus.

George Fox College had its beginnings when early Willamette Valley Quaker settlers established Friends Pacific Academy in 1885 for the Christian education of their children. The college division was organized in 1891 to provide more advanced instruction for students. In 1949, because of the many colleges in the Northwest with Pacific in their name, the College was renamed

— to George Fox University.

George Fox is accredited by the Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges. The College is one of 13 members of the national Christian College Consortium. GFC's undergraduate program is administered through three schools: Humanities, Natural and Behavioral Sciences, and Professional Studies. The 15 departments offer 34 majors with more than 600 courses.

An off-campus degree-completion program in either management and organizational leadership or management of human resources enrolls working adults in an evening program with classes in Portland, Salem and Eugene, Ore., and Boise, Idaho. Graduate programs offered are a Doctor of Psychology in clinical psychology, a Master of Arts in Teaching, a Master of Education, a Master of Business Administration, and a Master of Arts in Christian Studies.

The 74-acre tree-shaded campus a half-hour drive from Portland has undergone major expansion in recent years with 12 new buildings constructed. Part of a \$16 million Centennial Campaign, the \$5.3 million Edwards-Holman Science Center opened in the fall of 1994.

Alumni of George Fox are primarily in service-oriented vocations of Christian ministries, education, social work and medical fields. The College's most prominent alumnus is the late President Herbert Hoover, who attended Friends Pacific Academy.

The College is governed by a 42-member Board of Trustees elected by Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Church, which comprises nearly 8,000 members in approximately 50 churches in Oregon, Washington and Idaho.

Following a merger July 1, 1996, with Western Evangelical Seminary (a graduate school of 350 students in Tigard), the name will again change

Men's and Women's Track and Field/Cross Country Head Coach



Wes Cook

After a highly successful career in high school coaching, Wes Cook has turned George Fox College into a small college powerhouse in cross country and track and field.

In his nine years at the Newberg institution, his men's and women's teams have become regulars at the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) national meets. All four of his squads have finished among the top 15 in the nation, and they occasionally reach up and knock off NCAA Division 1 opponents.

In 1992, following the George Fox men's fifth-place and women's second-place finishes at the national meet, *Cross Country Express* magazine declared his cross country program best in the nation at the NAIA level. In George Fox's final year in the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA), his women's cross country team won the 1988 NCCAA national title with a record low score.

His athletes have won 48 NAIA All-American awards and have performed just as well in the classroom, earning 32 NAIA All-American Scholar-Athlete awards. In 1995, George Fox was the only

school to put both men's and women's teams in the top five of the NAIA cross country national meet team scholastic competition.

Cook hasn't gone unrecognized. He was named National Coach of the Year in women's cross country by the NCCAA in 1988 and the NAIA in 1992. In the West Coast region (NAIA Area I), he won Coach of the Year honors for men's cross country in 1990 and 1992.

At the district and conference level, he's earned Coach of the Year honors 12 times, at least once in each sport he coaches. In 1992-93, he was named NAIA District 2 Coach of the Year for all women's sports.

He's involved nationally as an NAIA national rater and has served on the NAIA women's track and field games committee and is a member of the U.S. Track Coaches Association.

A Nebraska native, Cook rose to the highest rank (Eagle) in the Boy Scouts of America before going on to become a four-time conference track scorer at the University of Northern Colorado. He set the school record at the 800-meter distance and helped the mile relay team to four consecutive conference wins. He was the national winner of the Holmes Award, given to the most outstanding senior in Alpha Kappa Lambda, a national collegiate fraternity.

In 1961, he graduated with a

degree in physical education and history. He earned a Master of Arts in Teaching at Lewis & Clark College in Portland in 1975.

Cook served 26 years as a head coach at five high schools in three states. During his 15 years at Gladstone High School, his track and cross country teams finished as Oregon state champion or runner-up 10 times. His boy's cross country team went undefeated for 51 straight dual meets, and he was named Oregon class 2A (now 3A) High School Coach of the Year for all sports three times.

In 1983, his son Toby set the Oregon class 3A state record in the 1,500-meter race.

Cook has served as president of the Oregon Track and Cross Country Coaches Association and the Oregon Association of The Athletics Congress (now U.S. Track and Field). He's been active in Fellowship of Christian Athletes and summer track and basketball camps. He's led four international tour teams and has traveled to 15 countries.

Cook has spoken at clinics and seminars nationwide and authored articles in state and national publications.

In addition to his coaching duties, Cook also is associate professor of health and human performance at George Fox.

He has three adult children; Tammy, Toby and Brad.

Assistant Track Coaches



John Luccio

JOHN LUCCIO has been an assistant coach at George Fox since 1989, but he has more than 35 years of coaching and teaching experience.

He has held the head track coaching position at Illinois Valley High School, Cave Junction High School and Sherwood High School, and assisted at the University of California - Santa Barbara and West Linn High School.

He was a track and football athlete while earning his bachelor's degree at Bowling Green State University in Ohio. He went on to earn master's degrees at Bowling Green and the University of Oregon.

Now George Fox's throwing coach, he was the sprint and relay coach until 1995.

Luccio continues to be active, setting the Oregon, 300-meter hurdles state master's record in 1995.

Currently, he is an physical education specialist at Archer Glen Elementary in Sherwood.

He and his wife, Margaret, have seven children and live in West Linn.

SCOTT BROWN came to George Fox as a student-athlete in 1987, the same year Wes Cook took the head coaching position.

A member of Madison High School's 1986 state championship track team, he earned first-team all-state honors in the 4x400-meter relay in 1987.

At George Fox, he was a four-year letterwinner in track and cross country and qualified for the NAIA national decathlon and 400-meter hurdles. Three of his years, he was the leading point scorer on the track team.

He earned his bachelor's degree in math teaching in 1991. After serving as an assistant coach at Clackamas Community College in 1992, he joined the George Fox coaching staff. His responsibilities are the hurdles, jumps and multi-events. Of the athletes he's coached at George Fox, 20 have qualified for NAIA national competition and five earned NAIA All-American honors.

Brown currently teaches sixth-grade math at Gregory Heights Middle School in the Portland School District and lives in Newberg.

DAVE GUZMAN became the George Fox sprints and relay coach in 1994-95 after spending a dozen years guiding Salem Academy's sprinters to prominence at the state level.

In his eight seasons prior to joining the George Fox coaching staff, 30 of his relay teams qualified for the Oregon Class 2A state meet, 29 scored points, and 17 took state titles. Six athletes won individual state titles.

At George Fox, he coached three relay teams to national appearances in his first year.

Guzman has 20 years of track and field coaching experience, including three years as co-founder and president of the Santiam Striders Track Club.

A graduate of Linfield College, he owns an insurance business in Salem.

He and his wife, Judy, live in Kaiser and have four children.

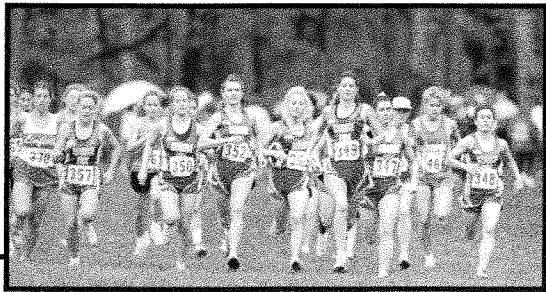
