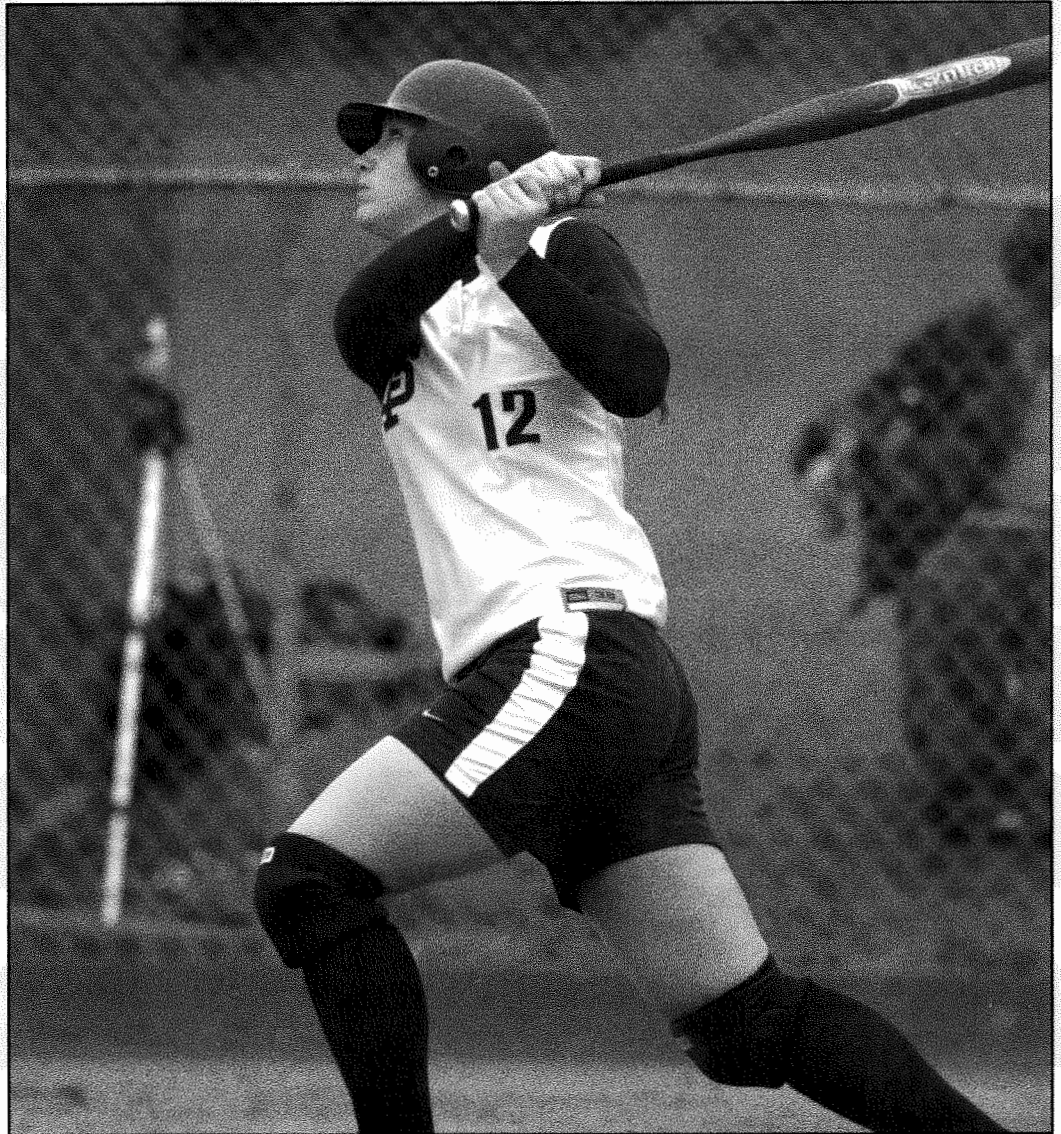

Cassie Halvorson, who owns the third-longest streak of consecutive at bats without a strikeout (186) in NCAA Division III history, was a First Team All-Northwest Conference outfielder in 2005 after batting .289 with 6 double, 3 triples, a home run, 13 RBI, 15 runs scored, and 7 stolen bases.

Staff ace Michelle Roberts posted a 3.71 ERA while leading the Bruins in wins (5), complete games (12), innings pitched (105.2) and strikeouts (77) in 2005.



On the cover: Outfielder Katie Plumb led the Bruins in doubles (7) and RBI (19) while batting .283, second on the team, in 2005.
