# G E O R G E F O X B A S E B A L L C O A C H



**PAT BAILEY**  
Head Coach

As George Fox University baseball coach Pat Bailey enters his 9th season with the Bruins, he can point with pride to a program that has established

itself as one of the finest in the Northwest Conference and at the NCAA Division III national level.

The Bruins have posted 8 straight winning seasons under Bailey, giving him a 222-110 career record and winning percentage of .668 that ranks in the top 30 among active coaches in Division III. He has more wins and a higher winning percentage than any other coach in Bruin baseball history. In home games under Bailey, the Bruins have posted an amazing mark of 108-27 (.800).

George Fox teams have won 5 NWC championships in Bailey's 8 seasons, including the 2003 title in which the Bruins went 18-5 in league play, earning Bailey his 5th conference Coach of the Year honor. By winning the league crown, the Bruins advanced to the NCAA West Regional, where they defeated Pomona-Pitzer and Chapman before dropping two to Chapman on the final day. Chapman went on to win the Division III national championship. The Bruins finished 31-13 overall and were ranked 14th in the season's final poll, their highest place ever at the end of a season.

The Bruins were NWC runners-up in 1996 and 1998, champions in 1997, 2000, and 2002, and co-champions in 1999. In 2000, their first year of NCAA eligibility, the Bruins advanced to the NCAA Division III West Regional and earned the regional's No. 1 seed. In 2002, the Bruins went 1-2 in the Midwest Regional, earning their first NCAA

post-season victory with a 9-1 decision over Blackburn.

The Northwest Conference also honored Bailey as its Coach of the Year in 1997, 2000, and 2002, and in 1999, he was Co-Coach of the Year with Linfield's Scott Carnahan as the two rivals shared the league crown.

Many of Bailey's players have earned all-conference, all-district, all-region, and/or all-America recognition, including 9 members of last year's team. In 1999, 1st baseman Nate Barnett became his first NAIA First Team All-American, and in 2000, staff ace Ryan Alvis was named to the NCAA Division III All-America Third Team. Last year, first baseman Eric Bell was an All-America First Team selection, and pitcher Scott Hyde was All-America Second Team. Bell was a First Team Academic All-American and designated hitter Joshua Sargent was Second Team.

Bailey took over the Bruin program immediately after guiding West Linn High School into the Oregon Class 4A state championship game in 1995. At West Linn, his teams advanced to the Class 4A state playoffs 7 times, and in his final season were edged 2-1 in the 1995 state championship game.

Four times Bailey was named Three Rivers League Coach of the Year while at West Linn, where he served for 10 years as head baseball coach and assistant football coach. His baseball teams won 5 league titles and reached the Oregon semifinals in 1989, 1991, and 1995. From 1989-95, his combined record as a high school and American Legion coach was 315-105 (.750).

Prior to West Linn, Bailey taught and coached at Willamette High School in Eugene, Ore., for 3 years. He has worked at

various baseball camps, and served as a pitching coach at the University of Portland in 1992.

"George Fox really matches up with me personality-wise and philosophically," says Bailey. "As a coach, I want to make sure every kid is making the most of his God-given talent. I want them to be a class act in the classroom and the community. I want the kids to match the school and my personality. I stress to my team that we're a family. Family members are more important than themselves. If you're going to be a leader, you must be a servant first."

Bailey is a 1974 graduate of Moscow High School in Idaho, where he played football, basketball, and was the baseball team's MVP. He earned 2 letters in baseball at North Idaho College in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, then 2 more as a starting outfielder and team captain during his senior season at the University of Idaho. He continued playing semiprofessionally until age 28.

In 1978, Bailey completed his business education degree, and earned a master of education degree in educational administration at the University of Oregon in 1983.

At West Linn, Bailey was also a business instructor, and in 1994 was named to Who's Who Among America's Outstanding High School Teachers. In 1995, he was one of 30 outstanding educators honored with a 1995 Education Excellence Award, given by Associated Oregon Industries.

At George Fox, Bailey is also associate director of athletics, chair of the school's Sports Hall of Fame Committee, and a teacher in the Department of Business and Economics.

Bailey and his wife, Susan, live in Newberg and have two children: son Alex, 20, and daughter Ann, 17.

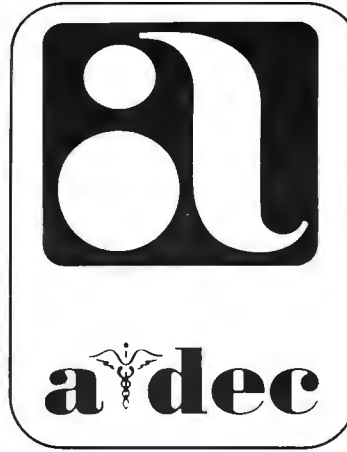

Righthanders Scott Hyde (l) and Mike Beck (r) were key components of the 2003 record-setting Bruin pitching staff. Hyde tied the GFU record for wins in a season while going 11-1, set a new strikeout record with 116, and posted a 2.63 ERA en route to First Team All-NWC, First Team All-West Region, and Second Team All-America honors. Beck set a new record for winning percentage while going 10-0, fanned 73, and ranked 21st nationally in ERA with a 1.76 mark, making First Team All-NWC and Second Team All-West Region. The Bruin staff as a whole was 23rd nationally with a 3.50 ERA and set a new team record with 306 strikeouts.

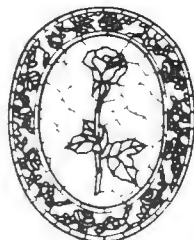

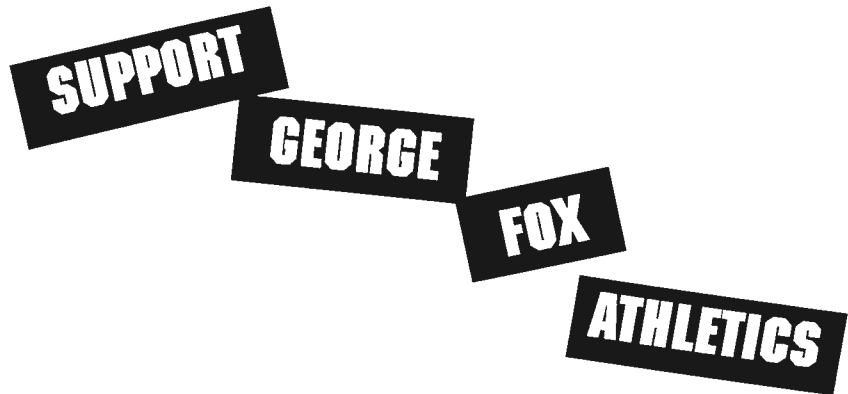

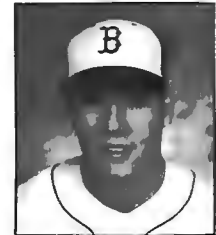
