Reports in the Alaska press indicate that George Fox College will establish an extension center in Kotzebue.

Inasmuch as the Alaska Legislature has undertaken a comprehensive study of the resources and programs of higher education in this state, with the consultation services from the nationally known firm of McLean and Associates, we would like to hear about your school's plans for Kotzebue.

The Legislative Council's Subcommittee on Higher Education will be meeting in Anchorage, Saturday, November 11, 1972, to consider other aspects of higher education in Alaska. On behalf of the members of the Subcommittee, I should like to extend an invitation to you to appear before the Subcommittee at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, November 11, in the Executive Suite of the Anchorage-Westward Hotel to discuss your program with the Subcommittee and its consulting staff.
