## 2009 COACHES



**MARTY HUNTER**  
Head Coach  
(2008-)

Continuing the outstanding tradition of winning baseball established by predecessors Pat Casey and Pat Bailey, who guided the Bruins to a record of in their 19 years at George Fox, **Marty Hunter** led the Bruins to a 28-14 record and yet another

berth in the NCAA Division III National Tournament in his first season as head coach in 2008.

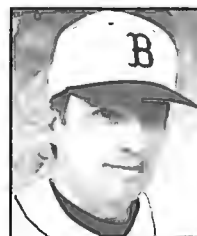
Hunter joined the George Fox staff as an assistant coach in 2003, and was named the Bruins' associate head coach in 2005. His primary coaching focus during that time was with the infielders. For five straight seasons (2003-2007), the George Fox defense ranked in the top six nationally in fielding average. The Bruins led the nation in that category in both 2003 and 2005, and set an NCAA Division III record in 2005 with a .979 fielding mark.

Hunter came to the George Fox program from Canby (Ore.) High School, which he guided to a 132-63 record from 1995 to 2002. His teams made the state Class 4A playoffs every year and won Pacific-9 Conference titles in 1997, 1998, and 2002. He was the Conference Coach of the Year in '97, '98, '01, and '02. Prior to his stint at Canby, Hunter coached Bend (Ore.) High School from 1991-94, going 68-40. Bend won the Intermountain Conference championship in 1991 and 1992, and he was named Coach of the Year in the conference both seasons. In 1990, he served as an assistant coach with the Bend Bucks, a team in the professional Class A Northwest League.

A graduate of Gresham (Ore.) High School, Hunter attended Linfield College, where he received two letters in football and three in baseball. He earned both dual business and health degrees from Linfield in 1984, and completed a master of education degree from Linfield in 1991. He and his wife of 23 years, Kim, reside in Canby and have two sons: Taylor, 19, a sophomore infielder with the Bruins, and Tucker, 16.
