2010 COACHES



MARTY HUNTER Head Coach

Marty Hunter, the 2009 Northwest Conference Co-Coach of the Year, has kept alive the tradition of excellence set by George Fox Sports Hall of Fame coaches Pat Casey and Pat Bailey by leading the nationally-recognized Bruins' baseball program to a 64-25 record in his first two seasons as head coach.

In Hunter's inaugural season in 2007, the Bruins posted a 28-14 record, went 24-8 in the Northwest Conference, finished second to Linfield by one game, and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Division III West Regional in Abilene, Texas. In 2008, the Bruins went 36-11, the second-most wins in a season in Bruin history, and defeated Pacific Lutheran in a one-game playoff after both teams went 27-5 to earn the NWC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. In the West Regional in McMinnville, Ore., the Bruins battled back after an opening-round loss to Cal Lutheran to defeat No. 1-ranked Pomona-Pitzer, Texas-Tyler, and Chapman, before Chapman eliminated the Bruins in the regional title game.

Hunter first came to George Fox as an assistant baseball coach in 2003, and was named the Bruins' associate head coach in 2005. In the summer of 2007,

he was named to replace Bailey, whose 12-year run with the Bruins included an NCAA Division III national title in 2004 and eight NWC championships, who left for an assistant's position at Oregon State.

Prior to joining the George Fox staff, Hunter led Canby (Ore.) High School to a 132-63 record from 1995-2002, with six state Class 4A playoff appearances, and Pacific-9 Conference titles in 1997, 1998, and 2002. He was the Pac-9 Coach of the Year in '97, '98, '01, and '02. He also coached Bend (Ore.) High School from 1991-94, going 68-40, winning Intermountain Conference titles in 1991 and 1992, and being named Coach of the Year in the league both seasons. In 1990, he served as an assistant coach with the Bend Bucks, a team in the professional Class A Northwest League.

A graduate of Gresham (Ore.) High School, Hunter attended Linfield College, where he received two letters as a football cornerback and three as a second baseman and catcher on the baseball team. He earned dual business and health degrees from Linfield in 1984, and completed a master of education degree from Linfield in 1991.

Hunter also serves as an instructor in the George Fox department of health and human performance. He and his wife of 24 years, Kim, have two sons: Taylor, 20, an All-Conference performer for the Bruins as a sophomore last year before transferring to Oregon State, and Tucker, 17. The Hunters reside in Canby.

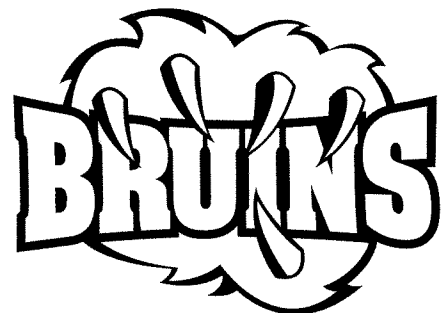

2009 NORTHWEST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONS (36-11, NWC 27-5)

Among the numerous records set by the 2009 Bruins was a new single-season standard for hits (589), while their .367 batting average was the second-highest in team history and ranked third nationally. George Fox led the nation in sacrifice flies (40) and ranked high in several other categories, including fifth in fielding percentage (.969), seventh in hits, eighth in slugging percentage (.546), 10th in runs (449), 17th in doubles (112), 18th in scoring (9.6), and 25th in home runs (48).
