

COACHING STAFF



Luis Del Rio, who led Woodburn (Ore.) High School to Oregon 5A boys' soccer state championships in 2010 and 2011, begins his fourth year as the head coach of men's soccer at George Fox University with the goal of reviving the Bruins' program in 2015. Last season, the Bruins posted a record of 2-16-1. They weren't able to secure a conference win, but the tides have turned in the men's soccer program in a positive way. Almost half of the losses that the Bruins recorded came at just a two-goal margin. In 2013, the Bruins went 1-19 and played 14 games with just a two goal

losing margin.

Del Rio is the seventh coach in the history of George Fox men's soccer, which began in 1977. He replaced Tim Tsohanataridis, who served two stints as the Bruins' coach (1986-89 and 2007-10) before returning to full-time teaching duties in the Christian studies department of the university. The Bruins posted a 2-16-1 in the new coach's initial season.

SEASON PREVIEW

With a new season in store and new faces on the roster, hopes are high for the men's soccer program. Just ask head coach Luis Del Rio about his 2015 men's soccer team and watch his eyes light up as he discusses the future of the program. "This is the year we build on the foundation that has been laid," proclaimed Del Rio. "Our guys have worked extremely hard this

offseason and it will show this year on the field."

Del Rio, who enters his fourth season at the helm of the program, knows what it takes to win. Before his time at George Fox, he led Woodburn High School to Oregon Class 5A boys' soccer state championships in 2010 and 2011.

He expects the 2015 Bruin team to impress not only the Northwest Conference, but the loyal fans who come to all the games. "We will have more talent this year," Del Rio said. "We brought in a great class that will help us this year and years to come." That's exactly what the team needs, as it graduated Luke Hammer, who was a four-time All-Northwest Conference honoree.



"We will be great up front," Del Rio said. "Luke was a great player and really helped us offensively, but this year we will have multiple guys who can attack the back line."



"Trevor will be a great asset for us on our front line, and Luis will frustrate opponents with his skill," mentioned Del Rio.

It won't just be the newcomers who will draw attention, either, as Joab Logan, Sean Owens and Connor Lopez all look to have standout seasons, according to Del Rio.

"I can't wait to watch Joab interact with our new guys in the front," he said. "Joab is very crafty and will create a lot of opportunities for us on offense. We will attack a lot more this year, and fans will see a lot of goals go in the back of the net."

Offense isn't the only thing Del Rio is excited about. He expects his defense to be more aggressive this year.

"Defensively we have gotten better," he said. "We made improvements in all three lines, and our defense has made great strides in the right direction."

The men will open up their season at home against La Verne on Wednesday, Sept. 2, at 6 p.m. Their conference schedule will start on the road this year, as they head to Pacific Lutheran and Puget Sound on Sept. 19 and 20, respectively.
