SCOTT RUECK
Head Coach

In just seven years, Scott Rueck has established himself as one of the brightest new lights on the horizon of college coaching - at any level. In that time, he has guided the George Fox University women's basketball team to a 130-49 record, a .727 winning percentage, four postseason playoff appearances, and national recognition in the NCAA Division III top 20.

Rueck's 2002-03 Bruins put together another winning season, as they have every year since he became the coach. The Bruins finished 15-10 overall and placed fourth in the Northwest Conference with a 10-6 league mark.

The Bruins' two finest season ever came under Rueck's leadership. The 1999-2000 team went 23-5, tied for the NWC crown, and made its first appearance in the NCAA National Tournament, winning two games before falling in the sectionals.

In 2000-01, the Bruins went 23-3 record to set a new record winning percentage (.885). The team tied records for wins in a season and consecutive wins (11) set the previous year, captured its first outright Northwest Conference title with a 15-1 league mark, and advanced to the second

round of NCAA National Tournament. Holding a 20-1 record at one point in the season, the Bruins spent two weeks as the No. 1-ranked team in the nation, ending with a final regular-season ranking of No. 4. Rueck was honored as Northwest Conference Co-Coach of the Year after earning the honor outright the year before.

Though only 34, Rueck already has 14 years of coaching experience. While still a student at Oregon State, he was an assistant boys' coach at Santiam Christian High (1989-93). He served as a women's assistant under George Fox head coach Sherri Murrell (193-95), and coached the women's tennis team (1995-96). When Murrell left, Rueck was named interim head coach for a year, then permanent head coach after a national search that yielded four finalists.

Rueck's players have earned four NAIA All-America awards, two NCAA All-America awards, and 18 All-Northwest Conference awards.

Rueck also teaches in the department of health and human performance, and directs the Victory Hoop Camp for Portland youth. A graduate of Glencoe High in Hillsboro, Ore., he earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science in 1991 and a master of arts in physical education teaching in 1992, both from Oregon State.

Rueck lives in Newberg with his wife, Kerry, who played basketball for George Fox from 1993-95. The Ruecks welcomed their first child, son Cole Michael, on Oct. 21 of this year.



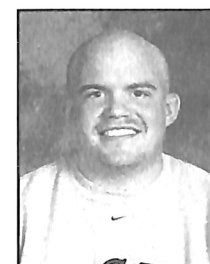

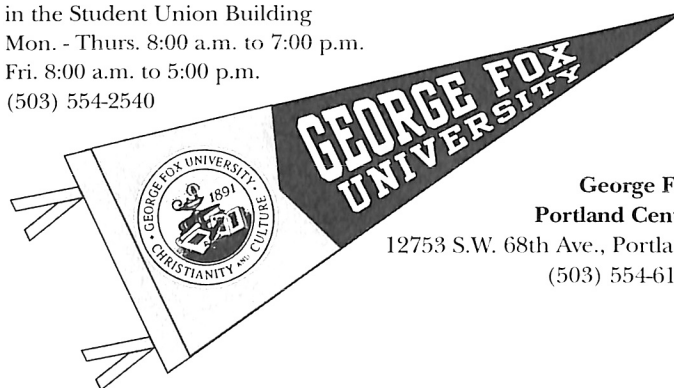

MARK SUNDQUIST Head Coach

After three years of laying a foundation for his George Fox University men's basketball program, Mark Sundquist begins his fourth season with a growing belief that the Bruins are about to turn a corner

and head back toward the top of the Northwest Conference standings.

Named to the George Fox post on August 1, 2001, with little time to recruit, Sundquist's first team fashioned an 8-16 record against bigger, more talented opponents with a hustling brand of basketball and some incredible outside shooting, finishing second in the nation in three-point field goals per game (9.92). Still overmatched in size and skills in his second year, the Bruins went 5-20, and while their record last year climbed to only to 7-18, the quality of play improved dramatically. With some added size, the Bruins in 2003-04 expect to be at their highest level of competitiveness yet under Sundquist's leadership.

Sundquist took over the Bruin program, replacing 18-year veteran Mark Vernon, the winningest coach in school history, after a national search that ended ironically in the Bruins' backyard! During the 1999-2000 season, he had served as the boys' basketball coach at Newberg High School, only eight blocks from George Fox,

where he led a very young team that had only one returning player to a 5-18 record. Prior to that, he had spent two seasons as the boys' basketball coach at Woodburn (Ore.) High School.

Born on Nov. 24, 1965, in St. Helens, Oregon, Sundquist grew up in Hillsboro, Oregon, where he attended Glencoe High School. He was recruited by George Fox but elected to attend Seattle Pacific University, his mother's alma mater.

Sundquist earned four letters for the Falcons from 1984-88, playing shooting guard for three seasons alongside point guard Ritchie McKay, ex-Oregon State University coach and now the head coach at the University of New Mexico. He led the team in free throw percentage as a junior (.818) and a senior (.817), with his career mark of .819 ranking 7th all-time at SPU. He was team captain and MVP as a senior, averaging 14.1 points a game while shooting a team-best .514 from the field and .482 from three-point range, a school record at the time. In an 83-78 overtime loss at Division I Stanford that season, he scored a career-high 33 points while setting new records, since broken, for three-pointers made (7) and attempted (12) in a game. He was named All-Great Northwest Conference and All-NCAA Division II District VIII as a senior.

Sundquist graduated from Seattle Pacific in 1989 with a bachelor's degree in social sciences/secondary education. During his last year at SPU, he served as assistant women's basket-

ball coach. After three years coaching in the junior high ranks, he spent the 1992-97 seasons as an assistant for the boys' basketball program at Glencoe before taking the Woodburn job.

Sundquist is married to the former Sara Thompson of Bellevue, Wash., and they have one son, Jake, age 6 1/2, and a daughter, Kaitlyn, age 3. The Sundquists attend Countryside Community Church in Sherwood.
