The Development Assistance Committee collects data on ODA/OA commitments and disbursements at the level of individual aid activities in the Creditor Reporting System (CRS) and in the form of aggregates in the annual DAC Questionnaire.

Our both databases are available online for free.

CRS database online (on detailed data on development transactions) and DAC database online (on aggregate data for all donors) may be found at:

You will find there more detailed information on both of them and 'User's Guides' explaining how to use them.

In my research on Rwanda, I am using OECD figures for donor assistance to Rwanda 1990-1994 taken from a 1994 AID briefing paper. It would be better if I could quote an OECD source directly. On the web, I cannot get back that far. All I need are annual cumulative figures and areas of emphasis for the major donors, Belgium, Germany, France, Canada, Switzerland, World Bank and EU. I am wondering if someone could dig up a document that would have that in it.
