3. President's party insists on election for the National Assembly for
the Transition. The concentration parties agree that TNA should be
appointed. MRND - if RPF agrees so must other parties be.
4. Fair election not possible with current administrators. Refuse to
have draft electoral law debated in govt. Violence in countryside
hardens position MRND controls more muscle than others
6. No inter party contact Oct 24-26. MRND wants to meet with 11 others
8. Twa + Mugenzi agreed compromise in CND
11. PM blames RPF + concentration for impasse
12. Twa, believe only way out is to agree what has been
agreed and come home
14. Long discussion with West Bank. - parties need to find
mechanism for dialogue - can't force parties to talk
15. Twa further discussion during integration talks
17. Posturing on TNA is preliminary to real battle over
dividing cabinet portfolios.
