RECONCILIATION PROSPECTS BRIGHTEN

3. FORMER PRIME MINISTER DISMAS NSENGIYAREMYE IS BAK IN TOWN. HE ARRIVED NOVEMBER 30TH FROM MOMBASA WHBRE HE WAS PARTICIPATING IN THE CHURCH SPONSORED RCONCILIATION TALKS WITH THE FACTION OF THE MDR LED BY PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE FAUSTIN TWAGIRAMUNGU. APPARENTLY THE DISMAS FACTION OF THE PARTY IS EUPHORIC ABOUT THE RESULTS OF THE MOMBASA COMFERENCE: TWAGIRAMUNGU TOLD THE FRENCH AMBASSADOR THAT DISMAS HAD BEEN VERY DIFFICULT AT FIRST BUT EVENTUALLY HAD TAKEN A MORE REASONABLE POSITION. TW, FAUSTIN AND DISMAS, WILL CONTINUE TO NEGOTIATE REUNIFICATION OF THE MDR ON FRIDAY 12/3 UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE BISHOP OF KABGAYI. THIS MEDIATION CONFIDENTIAL

4. FORMER FOREIGN MINISTER BONIFACE NGULINZIRA TOLD CHARGE AT THE WEEKEND THAT HE HAS BECOME AM ARDENT PROMOTER OF RECONCILIATION BETWEEN THE TWO WINGS OF THB PARTY. NGULINZIRA OBSERVED THAT THE BROAD BASED GOVBRNMENT WILL HAVE THE TASK OF IMPLEMENTING THE PEAE ACCORDS, AND IMPLIED THAT TWAGIRAMUNGU WILL INDEED TAKE UP HIS POSITION AS PRIME MINISTER. SAID IT WOULD BE VERY DIFFICULT FOR THE MDR TO FORM A OPPOSITION OPPOSING PEACE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF TH PEACE ACCORDS. THEREFORE, HE REASONED, THE MDR MRMBERS OPPOSING FAUSTIN HAVE NO ALTERNATIVE BUT TO FIND A WAY TO WORK TOGETHER WITH HIM AGAIN. ASKED IF THIS MEANT THE HUTU EXTREMISTS IN THE PARTY WERE MARGINALIZED, HE SAID THEY WERE STILL FIGHTING BITTERLY WITHIN THE PARTY POLITICAL BUREAU AGAINST RECONCILIATION. HE ACKNOWLEDGED HE COULD NOT CONTINUE TO ALLY HIMSELF WITH THESE ETHNICISTS.
