5. Pres. convened. ^{at 11:00 AM.} Nuncio, Belg, Fr, Egypt, Tanz. U.S., German, French. - Nuncio stressed security leaders of teams just rundown - U.S. politics erupting outside any framework. without gov. and N/A involves to street and violence
7. Pres. say he support accord, wanted peace, understood corps concern about security
10. Tanzanian Amb said 1/8 meeting of Pres & RPF
11. changed him with addressing PL differences. Lands walked out b4r Tang put forward its proposals
12. PL Lands communique accused Tang Amb. of meddling, in a dangerous exercise; medication effort a Presidential manoeuvre
13. Meeting with Ugandan ~~Kateteziwe~~ Kateteziwe. RPF selected a well-argued position not open to pd. compromise or looking forward toward long-term future of co-existence within a Hutu dominated country. Ug Amb said he was going to see Museveni and would try to get a better fix before he died.
