MRND supported its decision not to participate in govt when  
MRND is marginalized. Western Ambassadors believe  
MRND should be encouraged to join the govt on the basis of what they  
interpretations can be made on the Jan 9 Protocol as no fact of  
ship. The Pres & his party have choice of accommodating Renews  
or preparing for war
