Twin way for UN to help it on

- 1. Use UN expertise avoid pay PKO through Assessment
- 4. NMOC - in buffer zone "by all accounts is not doing a very good job"
- 5. fulfill PRD - 13
Threat to UN's order includes with aggression by rebel forces located in Ug.
disputed areas does not spill over to peace enforcement
- 6. This is one case where parties actually seem to be deploying the will to lay down their arms + move to a peaceful settlement as opposed to other areas (Angola, Bosnia, Georgia) where the goodwill of participants is questionable ...
Turning away from this call for help could have tragic human consequences
- 9. Russia + UK wary of undermining another costly PKO
