Dear Friend: --

On behalf of the American Priends Service Committee, of which immett ". Gulley is executive secretary of the Gregon branch, of the local service committee, of which my wife is chairman, and of the Friends Shurch, of which Carl D. Byrd is pestor, I am extending to you and your people a very cordial invitation to hear John Hollister, who will speak at the Friends Church at 8:00 o'clock Thursday evening, Movember 13, on conditions in Europe, and especially in Cermany.

Mr. Hollister has been teacher, newspaper man, world traveler and public lecturer, and for the past two years has been one of the executives of the merican Friends Service Committee, in charge of derman relief. He has just returned from two months epent in a 2,000 mile jeep trip through all four of the somes of Germany and in Berlin, and has had an exceptional opportunity to learn at first hand the actual conditions in that unfortunate country.
