((TEXT)) ((WORDS INDISTINCT)) REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REPUBLICAN DEMOCRATIC MOVEMENT, CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC PARTY, SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY, AND LIBERAL PARTY AND THOSE OF THE RWANDAN PATRIOTIC FRONT ((RPF)) ARE CONTINUING THEIR MEETING IN BUJUMBURA. THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL MOVEMENT FOR DEMOCRACY AND DEVELOPMENT DOES NOT WANT TO KNOW ABOUT THE MEETING. ((PASSAGE INDISTINCT)) THAT BECAME CLEAR WHEN IT AFFIRMED THAT IT COULD NOT SEND ITS DELEGATES TO BUJUMBURA.

AT THE MEETING, THE RPF DEMANDS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: ONE, THAT ALL THE GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES WHO TOOK PART IN THE KILLINGS AND VIOLENCE AGAINST THE PEOPLE BE SACKED; TWO, THAT THE GOVERNMENT SHOWS THE WILLINGNESS AND RESOLVE TO PREVENT FUTURE VIOLENCE AND TAKE PUNITIVE MEASURES AGAINST WHOEVER MAY START THE VIOLENCE AGAIN; AND THREE, AS THE FRENCH TROOPS HAVE BECOME A PROBLEM IN RWANDA RATHER THAN A SOLUTION TO THE RWANDAN PROBLEM, THEY MUST LEAVE RWANDA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
