GUIDELINES FOR MONITORING OF TRUCE

1. The Rwandese Government and the Rwandese Patriotic Front have agreed to observe a one-week truce in the renewed fighting between their forces. The truce takes effect from midnight 15 Feb 93.
2. Both parties have also indicated that NMOC should monitor the truce which would be used to discuss the latest general developments. To make the monitoring of the truce meaningful, there is a need to lay down guidelines which all parties involved are requested to observe.
3. The guidelines are as follows:
  - a. The Rwandese Government Forces (RGF) and the Rwandese Patriotic Army (RPA). The RGF and the RPA are expected to cease all forms of hostilities from 2359 hours 15 February 1993 to 2359 hours 22 February 1993. For the purpose of clarity, hostility shall mean:
    - (1) Any movement forward of present disposition by either main forces or patrols.
    - (2) Any firing of personal weapons, machine guns, and other direct and indirect fire weapons.
    - (3) Any laying of mines.
    - (4) Any presence of foreign troops in the combat zones.
  - b. NMOC
    - (1) Zonal Commanders. NMOC Zonal Commanders shall:
      - (a) Be responsible for the overall security of their officers and must take all necessary measures to ensure it.
      - (b) In conjunction with their RGF and RPF liaison officers determine safe patrol routes to all new battle positions of all new battle positions.
      - (c) Confirm all current dispositions of forces.
      - (d) Monitor violations as stated in paragraph 3 a.

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

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(2) Chief Military Observers: Chief Military Observers of the RPF and RPA shall:

- (a) Liaise with their various forces to determine safe routes for NMOG patrols to their various battle positions.
- (b) Liaise with their various forces to respect the neutrality of NMOG.
- (c) Make arrangement for the overall security of NMOG personnel in the field.
- (d) Brief their respective zonal liaison officers on safe routes and the general security measures taken to protect NMOG personnel.
