Dean Freiday, a member of the Christian and Interfaith Relations Committee of Friends General Conference since 1958 and its chairman from 1966 until 1972, has represented Friends in a number of ecumenical capacities: as delegate from FGC to the Fourth World Conference on Faith and Order of the World Council of Churches at Montreal in 1963; as an observer-consultant from Friends World Committee at the Third World Congress of the Lay Apostolate at the Vatican in 1967; as a consultant representing FWCC at the annual meetings of the Secretaries of the World Confessional Families in Geneva in 1968, 1969, 1972, and 1973.
