BRUIN BITS: The Bruins' matches with Lewis & Clark have swapped sites due to a scheduling conflict with the Pioneers' Pamplin Sports Center on Oct. 21. Tomorrow's match will be played in Portland, while the Oct. 21 game will be in Newberg ... In the latest NWC stats, Nicole Bostic ranks 9th in kills (2.55 kpg) and 12th in digs (2.71 dpg); Mindi Yost is 3rd in assists (8.86 apg) and 8th in digs (3.26 dpg); Shelly Schultens is 6th in service aces (0.40 sapg) and 6th in blocks (0.94 bpg); Lynette Domench is 2nd in blocks (1.09 bpg) ... As a team, the Bruins are 1st in the NWC in blocks (2.56), 5th in kills (11.71) and digs (16.06), 6th in hitting pct. (.121) and assists (9.74), and 8th in service aces (0.97).

TONIGHT'S OPPONENT: This is the Boxers' third conference match of the season ... Pacific has lost three in a row, including 0-3 losses to NWC foes Whitworth and Whitman, and is coming off a non-conference loss (13-15, 12-15, 9-15) to Cascade College on Tuesday in which they hit a season-low .032 pct. ... The Boxers' top returning player is Second Team All-Northwest Conference middle blocker Ann Kaltwasser, who was second on the team in kills ... In the latest NWC stats, setter Chris Beck ranks 7th in assists (6.43 apg), but she is the only Boxer listed among the league leaders ... As a team, Pacific ranks 5th in the conference in service aces (1.43), 7th in hitting pct. (.095), kills (10.50), and blocks (1.71), and 8th in assists (7.71) and digs (11.64) ... Pacific will host pre-season NWC favorite Pacific Lutheran tomorrow at 4:00 p.m. in a match to be played at Forest Grove High School due to ongoing construction of a new gym floor at the Pacific Athletic Center.
