**BRUIN BITS:** Setter Mindi Yost was named NWC Player of the Week for Sept. 18-24. In wins over Pacific and Lewis & Clark, she totaled 92 assists (13.14 apg), 40 digs (5.71 dpg), and had 8 blocks (1.14) in 7 games ... In the latest NWC stats, Nicole Bostic ranks 12th in kills (2.72 kpg); Yost is 3rd in assists (9.55 apg) and 6th in digs (3.67 dpg); Shelly Schultens is 4th in blocks (1.05 bpg) and 6th in service aces (0.41 sapg); Lynette Domench is 6th in blocks (1.00 bpg) ... As a team, the Bruins are 1st in the NWC in blocks (2.61), 4th in digs (17.88), 5th in kills (12.21) and assists (10.48), 7th in hitting pct. (.125), and 8th in service aces (1.10).

**TONIGHT'S OPPONENT:** The Wildcats are on a four-game winning streak, and have pushed their conference record to 4-0, tying the University of Puget Sound for first place in the NWC ... Linfield has defeated Willamette and Pacific Lutheran on the road and Whitman and Whitworth at home in their last four matches ... The Linfield leader is two-time All-Conference middle blocker Anna Gradek, who is making a spirited bid for a third such honor. She ranks 2nd in the NWC in kills (3.78 kpg), 4th in hitting pct. (.261), and 12th in blocks (0.81 bpg) and digs (3.19 dpg) ... Other Wildcats among the league leaders are Sara Kaiser, 3rd in hitting pct. (.270 and 6th in kills (3.31); Denise Lum-Lung, 8th in hitting pct. (.226) and 11th in digs (3.36); Katie Leitheiser, 6th in assists (8.17) ... As a team, Linfield ranks 4th in the NWC in hitting pct. (.174), 6th in kills (12.14) and digs (16.97), 8th in assists (9.61) and blocks (1.81), and 9th in service aces (1.06) ... The Bruins and Wildcats split last year, Linfield winning in McMinnville 15-7, 6-15, 16-14, 16-14 while NWC Player of the Year Sharon Barnett was out off the GFU lineup with an ankle injury, and George Fox returning the favor in Newberg with a 15-6, 15-2, 15-8 sweep.
