BRUIN BITS: Setter Mindi Yost was named NWC Player of the Week for Sept. 18-24. In wins over Pacific and Lewis & Clark, she totaled 92 assists (13.14 apg), 40 digs (5.71 dpg), and had 8 blocks (1.14) in 7 games ... In the latest NWC stats, Yost is 2nd in assists (9.75 apg) and 7th in digs (3.73 dpg); Shelly Schultens is 3rd in blocks (1.08 bpg) and 8th in service aces (0.35 sapg); Lynette Domench is 8th in blocks (0.93 bpg) ... As a team, the Bruins are 1st in the NWC in blocks (2.57), 3rd in digs (18.35), 6th in kills (12.23), 7th in assists (10.67 and hitting pct. (.118), and 9th in service aces (1.06) ... Entering this season, Bruins coach Steve Grant ranked 13th among active D-III coaches in career wins with 424.

TONIGHT'S OPPONENT: The Pirates, who had an off-day yesterday, are coming off a 15-17, 11-15, 14-16 setback at Whitman on Wednesday ... All six starters and their top eight players are back for the Pirates this year ... Whitworth was picked to finish 5th in the pre-season conference coaches' poll ... Middle blocker Kristen Turner paces the NWC in blocks with 1.24 per game, ranks 5th in kills (3.39), 7th in hitting pct. (.237), and is a two-time NWC Player of the Week Honorable Mention this season ... Other Pirates among the league leaders are Gretchen Smith, 4th in digs (3.80) and 12th in kills (2.63); Nicole Weedman, 5th in assists (9.26) and 9th in aces (0.35); and Abby Jo Hornstein, 4th in aces (0.42) and 5th in digs (3.77) ... As a team, the Pirates are 4th in aces (1.80), 5th in hitting pct. (.164) and blocks (2.02), 6th in assists (10.91) and digs (17.70), and 7th in kills (12.20) ... The Bruins defeated the Pirates in both of their meetings last season ... The Pirates' next match is Friday, Oct. 13, at Lewis & Clark at 7:00 p.m.
