(.125) and 8th service aces (1.20) ... Individually, Mindi Yost is 3rd in assists (10.39) and in digs (4.06); Shelly Schultens is 4th in blocks (1.00) and 6th in aces (0.41); Lynette Domench is 7th in blocks (0.89); and Jennifer Westerberg is 12th in digs (3.33) ... Bruins coach Steve Grant was 13th among all-time active D-III coaches in career wins with 424 entering this season ... Tonight in the final home game in the careers of seniors Amy Forbes and Bree Stairs, who will be honored in pre-game ceremonies.

In the most recent NWC stats, Willamette is 1st in digs (21.41); 4th in assists (11.73); 5th in kills (12.68) and blocks (2.06), and 6th in hitting percentage (.140) and service aces (1.30) ... Kelly Sorenson is 1st in digs (5.99), ranking No. 1 nationally as well, and 3rd in kills (3.75); Kelli Truax is 6th in blocks (0.97) and 9th in hitting percentage (.218); Diana Chamberlain is 7th in assists (7.24); Jenni Linden is 7th in hitting percentage (.229), 9th in kills (2.90) and 10th in blocks (0.87).
