CHARTER

This Corporation shall be known as Pacific College, and shall be of perpetual continuance.

The object of this College shall be to give a thorough training in the Arts and Sciences, and to teach those subjects ordinarily coming in a course of College training. It shall strive in every possible manner to spread Christian Culture.

It shall be empowered to buy, sell and hold real estate, personal effects, moneys, notes, trust funds, and such other properties or valuables as may appear to the interest of said College.

The management of said College shall be vested in a Board of Trustees, to be appointed by the Monthly, Quarterly, or Yearly Meeting of Friends Church at Newberg Ore.

The said College shall be located at Newberg, Yamhill County, State of Oregon.
