TRACK AND FIELD

When the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball decided in 1952 to fill the need for an extensive post-season events program for the nation's smaller colleges and expanded into the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics, the first event to be added in the minds of most, was a track and field meet.

In fact, a regional meet had been held in 1951 at Kansas State Teachers College, Emporia, and had been highly successful. So it was with no delay that plans were immediately inaugurated to hold the NATA Track and Field Championships on a national basis in June of 1952. Abilene, Texas, home of Abilene Christian College, a perennial track power, was selected as the site.

The Track and Field Championships were an immediate success and have since assumed the role of one of the "big three" among NATA events, along with the basketball and football programs. A steadily increasing flow of top talent has attended the meets and nationwide participation has advanced past the hope stage into one of reality.

The Track and Field Championships remained at Abilene for four years, attaining a great degree of stature in that time. In 1956, it was decided to take this event to the West Coast, traditional site of the nation's power track teams. San Diego, California hosted the meet that year and for the next two.

In 1959, the event was moved to Howard Wood Memorial Stadium in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, where local enthusiasm, on the part of both officials and fans, has made it a tremendous success.

TRACK AND FIELD

When the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball decided in 1952 to fill the need for an extensive post-season events program for the nation's smaller colleges and expanded into the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics, the first event to be added in the minds of most, was a track and field meet.

In fact, a regional meet had been held in 1951 at Kansas State Teachers College, Emporia, and had been highly successful. So it was with no delay that plans were immediately inaugurated to hold the NAIA Track and Field Championships on a national basis in June of 1952. Abilene, Texas, home of Abilene Christian College, a perennial track power, was selected as the site.

The Track and Field Championships were an immediate success and have since assumed the role of one of the "big three" among NAIA events, along with the basketball and football programs. A steadily increasing flow of top talent has attended the meets and nationwide participation has advanced past the hope stage into one of reality.

The Track and Field Championships remained at Abilene for four years, attaining a great degree of stature in that time. In 1956, it was decided to take this event to the West Coast, traditional site of the nation's power track teams. San Diego, California hosted the meet that year and for the next two.

In 1959, the event was moved to Howard Wood Memorial Stadium in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, where local enthusiasm, on the part of both officials and fans, has made it a tremendous success.

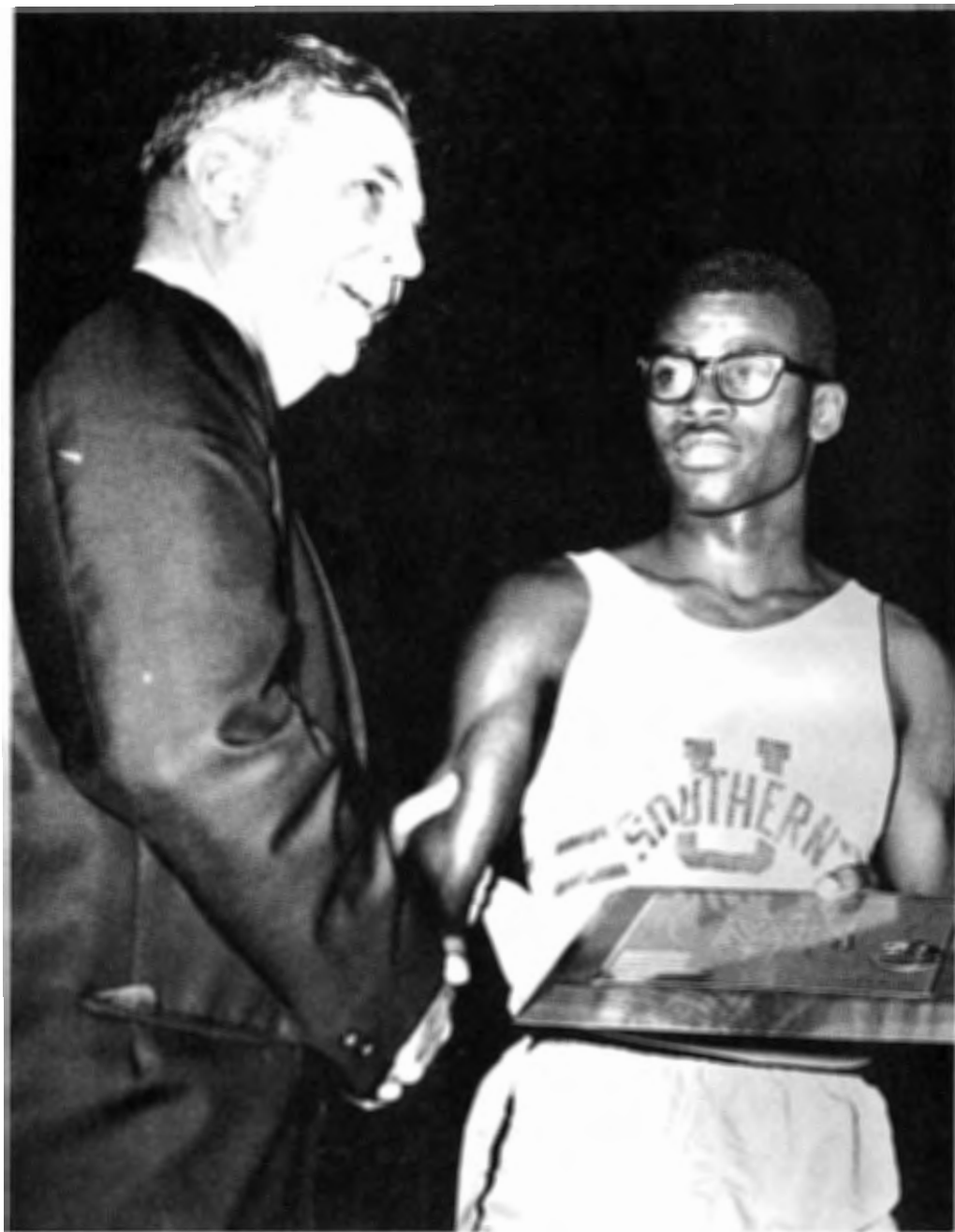

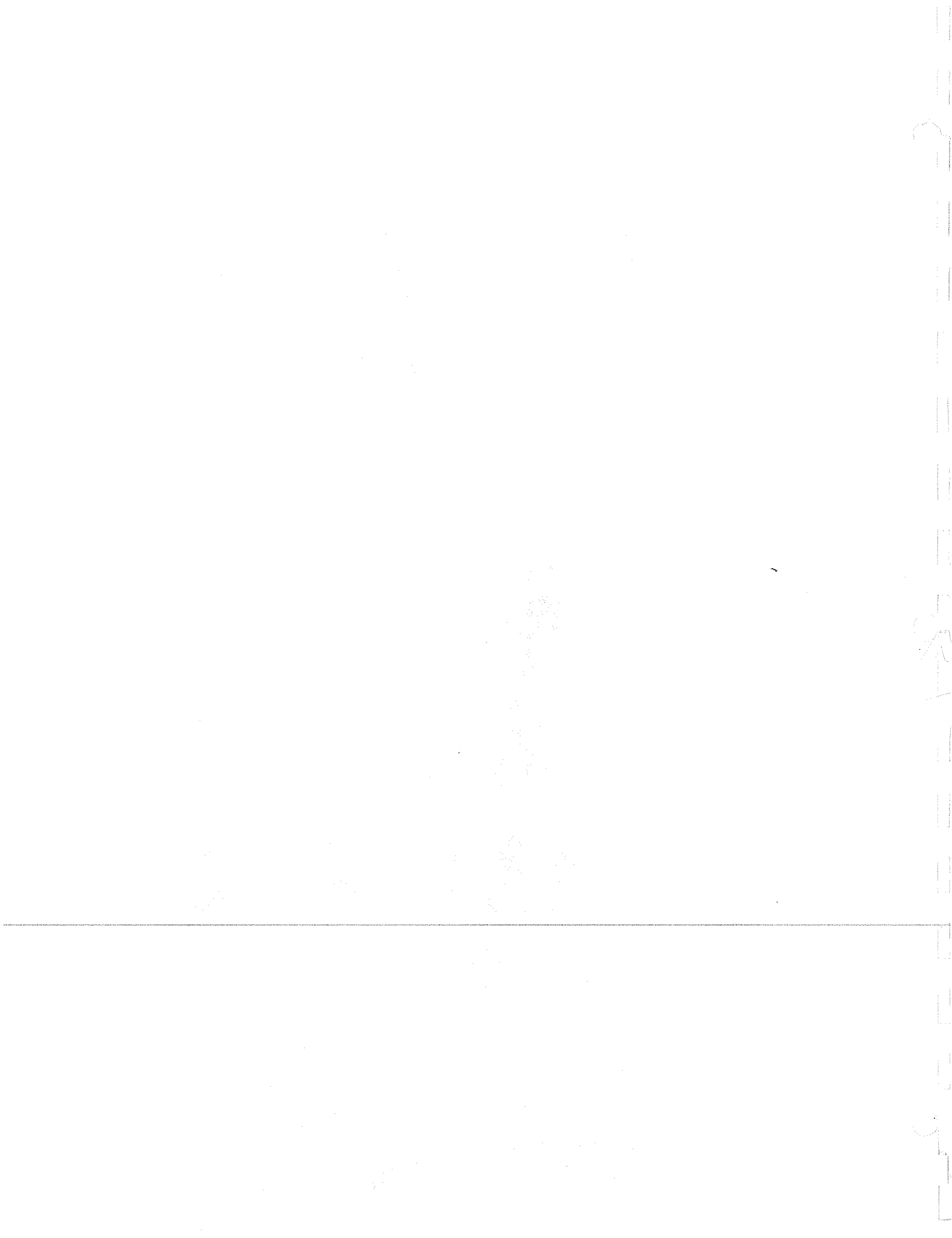

OUTDOOR TRACK AND FIELD

TRACK AND FIELD

When the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball decided in 1952 to fill the need for an extensive post-season events program for the nation's smaller colleges and expanded into the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics, the first event to be added in the minds of most, was an outdoor track and field meet.

In fact, a regional meet had been held in 1951 at Kansas State Teachers College, Emporia, and had been highly successful. So it was with no delay that plans were immediately inaugurated to hold the NAIA Track and Field Championships on a national basis in June of 1952. Abilene, Texas, home of Abilene Christian College, a perennial track power, was selected as the site.

The Track and Field Championships were an immediate success and have since assumed the role of one of the "big three" among NAIA events, along with the basketball and football programs. A steadily increasing flow of top talent has attended the meets and nationwide participation has advanced past the hope stage into one of reality.

The Track and Field Championships remained at Abilene for four years, attaining a great degree of stature in that time. In 1956, it was decided to take this event to the West Coast, traditional site of the nation's power track teams. San Diego, California hosted the meet that year and for the next two.

In 1959, the event was moved to Howard Wood Memorial Stadium in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, where local enthusiasm has made it a tremendous success.

Last January, the NAIA added a 13th championship to its annual schedule by holding its first National Indoor Track and Field Meet. The event was held in Municipal Auditorium in Kansas City and was highlighted by 14 events for NAIA member schools, seven open division events for men and three open division events for women.

Included in the field were 10 athletes who participated in the 1964 Olympics at Tokyo. Four athletes from West Germany and three from Great Britain were in the field as the Amateur Athletic Union made it possible for these athletes to include the NAIA meet in their United States' schedule.
