Team field goal shooting statistics perhaps give a clue to the championship success of Pacific Lutheran in the 1974 Northwest Conference race. The Lutes connected at a .472 rate while intimidating opponents to just .376 from the field as Gene Lundgaard's cagers finished comfortably atop NWC standings at 11-3, three games ahead of Pacific and Whitworth at 8-6.

Pacific forward Eldridge Broussard took season scoring honors with a 21.2 average, but he yielded league scoring honors to his teammate Greg Taylor at 20.5. Willamette's Mike Cashman was second in season scoring at 19.9, while Broussard trailed Taylor in league play at 20.1.

Cashman topped rebounding with an 11.6 average to 11.0 for College of Idaho's Jim McClelland. PLU's Lavelle Greer was the top field goal marksman on the season at .543, while Taylor topped free throw shooters with an .869 percentage. In league play, PLU's Jeff Byrd was the rebound leader at 10.6; Lute Randy Leeland topped field goal accuracy at .544; and Linfield's Bob Coma led free throw shooters at .913.

Linfield was the most prolific scoring team on the season with a 91.6 average, while Whitman yielded the fewest points on the average at 68.0. Willamette had the widest rebound margin over opponents at 6.1, while Lewis & Clark held a 3.3 average point spread over opponents.

Just one record was broken in scoring this season. Cashman snapped Willamette's single game scoring mark with 41 points, eclipsing the 40 total of Doug Holden in 1972.

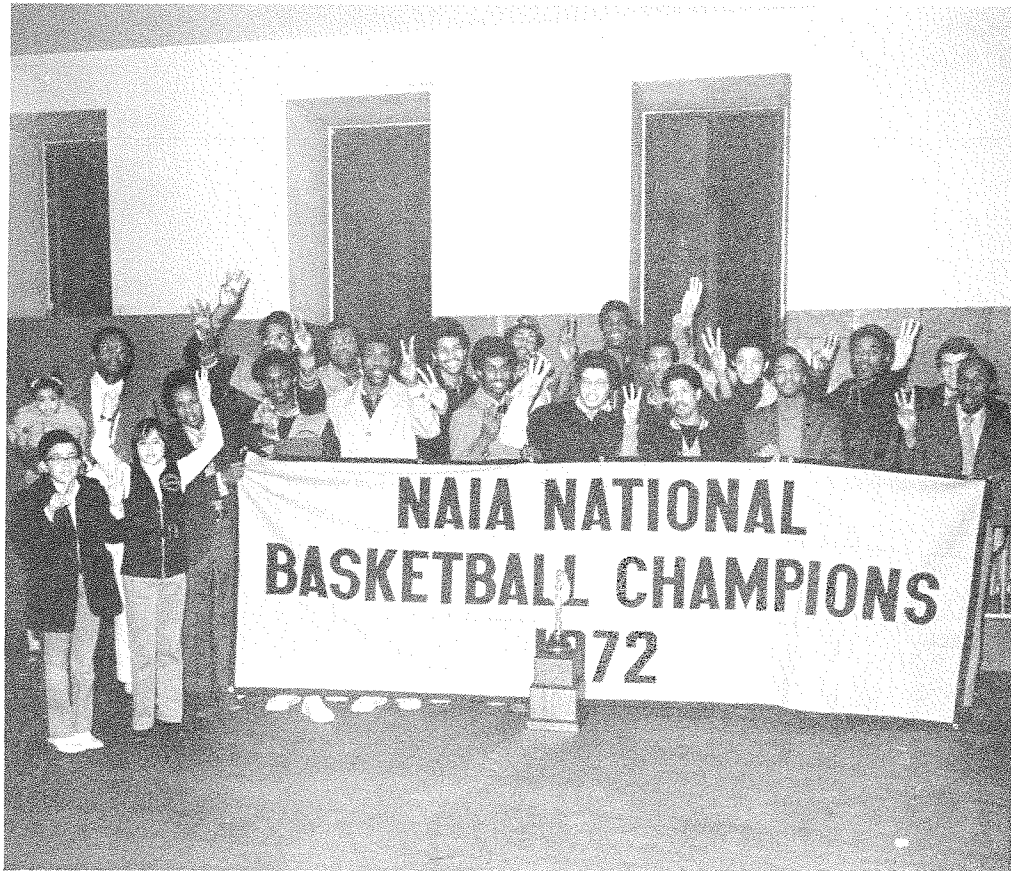

BASKETBALL

The NAIA National Intercollegiate Basketball Tournament was inaugurated in 1937 at Kansas City, Missouri as an eight-team tournament. It was expanded to a 32-team bracket in 1938 and the tournament has remained in that format since, with the exception of 1944, when no tournament was held because of World War II, and 1945, when the bracket was reduced to 16 teams because of wartime travel limitations.

The tournament, then known as the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball (NAIB) Tournament, was the first national championship tournament in the sport conducted by a national collegiate body. The NAIA basketball championships are administered by a tournament committee representing the NAIA Basketball Coaches' Association.

An all-time NAIA tournament attendance record was established in 1972 as 78,388 persons watched the 35th renewal of the oldest national intercollegiate basketball championships. Kentucky State, for the third straight year, dominated play in the tournament, beating Eau Claire State (WI), 71-62, in the championship game.
