Fairmont State (W.Va.) (6-0) who has to play Concord as well as Waynesburg, is in eighth position. Texas A&I (6-0) made the week's biggest jump from 13th to ninth place. Texas A&I will battle Southwest Texas State on November 18 in the Lone Star Conference showdown.

Central (Iowa) (7-0) overcame a tough Luther (Iowa) eleven, 14-7, to return to the Top Ten.

Making their first appearances in the Second Ten this week were Troy State (Ala.), --16th, Southwestern (Kan.)--17th, and William Jewell (Mo.)--20th.

With the semi-final games of the NAIA Champion Bowl less than a month away, there are still 21 NAIA football powers undefeated. The Champion Bowl game will be played December 9 at the site of one of the two finalists.

Oregon College of Education, co-champion with Southern Oregon in the Oregon Collegiate Conference, snared the lion's share of positions on the 1967 all-conference football team announced Tuesday by the coaches.

The Wolves claimed four berths on the first offensive team and four on the first defensive unit to far outdistance the field.

And two-way performer Dave Sturgis of OCE shared the individual spotlight with SOC quarterback Dan Miles.

It was the second straight year Sturgis has been named to both first teams--as an offensive end and defensive safety.

For Miles it was a return to the quarterback pinnacle after a year's absence and constituted his third all-conference slot in four years with the Red Raiders.

Miles passed for 1652 yards this season and swelled his four-year total to 6889 yards. He virtually rewrote the OCC aerial record book during his tenure.

OCE players joining Sturgis on the offensive team were guard Roy Nickerson, center Tom Mullen and halfback Bob Zeigler. Teammates on the defensive roster included end Jon Lamoreaux, middle guard Lorren Zink and linebacker Tom Hawkins.

Zink, Lamoreaux and Hawkins all won their second year of all-conference first team recognition, although Zink made the team as a tackle in 1966. SOC fullback Ron Williams--halfback last season--was another two-year man on offense, while Oregon Tech end Curlee Robinson and George Fox tackle Bob Hadlock were repeaters on defense.

Eastern Oregon had five first team berths including both offense and defense. SOC and George Fox claimed four each and OTI two.

Stalemates may not be the most satisfying things in the world, but they rank a good deal ahead of second place finishes. That's the way Oregon College of Education and Southern Oregon have to look at their co-championship finish in the Oregon Collegiate Conference.

The traditional rivals both finished 3-1 last Saturday, defending titlist OCE trimming Oregon Tech, 30-7, and Southern Oregon stopping George Fox, 32-20.

In OCE's case, it took a tremendous performance by a young, seldom seen scatback to turn the trick. Sophomore Dave Snook of Serra Catholic was the secret weapon.

Snook had carried the ball only 18 times through six games going into the clash, but he rambled 108 yards in 9 carries, caught 2 passes for 50 yards and scored three touchdowns against Oregon Tech.

Coach Howard Morris of the shell-shocked Owls put it best: "We were Snooked."

The OCE halfback's efforts earned him back-of-the-week honors in the conference, his performance just shading that of SOC's Dan Miles, who passed for 318 yards, completing 24-38 for a pair of touchdowns.

Miles' Red Raider teammate, John Franzen, won the lineman-of-the-week award for the second straight week with a fine effort. He caught 11 passes for 165 yards and three touchdowns, the scoring strikes on passes of 40, 27 and 17 yards.

Oregon College's Bob Zeigler moved into first place in rushing this week with 92 total yards, 40 more than Ron Williams of SOC, who has played one more game.

The old saw goes that one game does not a season make, but Eastern Oregon Coach Arch Dunsmoor has to count his squad's 1967 football campaign as pretty successful following a 7-6 upset of Oregon College of Education last Saturday.

The stunner leaves the Oregon Collegiate Conference football race in a state of flux with numerous possibilities. Of course, that's only if Oregon Tech can duplicate EOC's success against the defending champion Wolves in Klamath Falls.

Oregon College goes into its final counting contest at OTI Saturday with a 2-1 record, tied with Southern Oregon. But since the Wolves dumped SOC, 20-7, earlier, they could lay pretty fair claim to the prize if they win Saturday, deadlock or not.

Southern Oregon hosts George Fox, while EOC entertains Simon Fraser in a non-conference contest.

The snarl would develop if both OCE and SOC would fall. That would leave every club in the league 2-2.

But that's conjecture. On the concrete side, three OCC players shared the honors this week. Eastern Oregon defensive end Gordon Proctor and Southern Oregon offensive end John Franzen are co-linemen of the week, while OCE's Bob Zeigler is back of the week despite his team's defeat.

Proctor was a kingpin in the clutch for EOC, putting constant pressure on the quarterback and playing a key role in a good first half defense, which Dunsmoor termed the turning point.

Franzen caught 10 passes for 87 yards, scored a touchdown and had several run-springing blocks for the Red Raiders.

Zeigler gained 94 yards in 23 muddy carries and moved within striking distance of SOC's Ron Williams, who still leads the rushing statistics but has played one more game.

Surprising Oregon Tech and rebounding Southern Oregon unfurled top-flight performances as the Oregon Collegiate Conference's five teams completed launching of the 1967 football season last weekend.

Tech's 29-21 conquest of Chico State on the strength of a scathing first half and SOC's complete destruction of College of Idaho of the Northwest Conference, 61-6, served notice to defending OCC champion Oregon College of Education that two other units have title plans.

OCE staged a fine fourth-quarter comeback, scoring on the final play of the game, to come within a point of a strong Pacific team, 21-20.

But this weekend the OCC championship scramble begins, with OCE hoping to draw first blood in a host date with George Fox. The other three conference members continue non-counting action.

OTI, thanks to an earlier win over Moffett Air Force Base, 40-0, carries a 2-0 record into the weekend, while SOC is 1-1.

Southern Oregon's passing combination is still clicking despite a few problems in the season-opening loss to Portland State. Dan Miles has thrown 45 and completed 25 thus far for 253 yards and two touchdowns. His favorite target has been Rod Rumrey with 13 receptions, 162 yards and two touchdowns. But OCE's Dennis Sydow, who completed 12 of 24 for 212 yards against Pacific, is close behind.

SOC also claims the leading rusher thus far in fullback Ron Williams, who has carried 28 times for 153 yards.

Two punters are over the 40-yard average mark, Roger Carpenter of OTI at 41.2 on nine boots and Bob McGray of SOC at 41.0 on five.
