11/6 – PACIFIC LUTHERAN 5, GEORGE FOX 1: Ferguson's Hat Trick Leads Lutes to Win over Bruins

NEWBERG, Ore. – Mike Ferguson scored a three-goal "hat trick", leading the visiting Pacific Lutheran University Lutes to a 5-1 rout of the George Fox University Bruins in the season-ending Northwest Conference men's soccer game for both teams Saturday afternoon here at Morse Field.

Ferguson put the Lutes on the board just 11:50 into the game with a header past Bruin keeper Kyle Putnam after a cross from Matt Webb. At 41:45, Kevin Murray sent a pass toward Kelly LeProwse that Putnam tried to intercept, but LeProwse beat the keeper to the ball and launched an easy shot, his 2nd goal of the year, into the unprotected net.

Ferguson stepped to the fore again in the second half, scoring at 52:06 off a pass from Justin Stevens, and then intercepting a ball that had been played by a Bruin defender back toward the goal and firing it home at 63:41 for his 9th score of the season. The Lutes made it 5-0 at 68:49 when Murray fired a shot that Putnam saved but could not control, and Willy Devgun knocked home the rebound for his 2nd goal of the season.

George Fox notched its only goal at 76:01 when Craig Laughland crossed from the left side to Greg Hoiland, who booted it into the net for his 2nd score of the year.

The contest was a hard-fought, physical battle that saw 35 fouls called, two yellow cards, and one red. Putnam made 6 saves, while Matt Atwood and Jared Harman split halves in goal for PLU, Atwood making 2 saves and Harman 3.

The Bruins ended their season with a 5-12-2 overall record and 4-9-1 league mark, while the Lutes finished at 7-12-1 overall and 6-7-1 in the conference.

George Fox honored seven seniors playing their final game for the Bruins in pre-game ceremonies on the field: forwards Laughland and Michael Chapman, midfielders Max Sorensen and Jason Kintner, and defenders Chris Waters, Andrew Paine and Greg Cobb.

11/5 – GEORGE FOX 1, LINFIELD 0: Bruins Blank Wildcats on Putnam Saves and Laughland's Late Goal

McMINNVILLE, Ore. - George Fox goalkeeper Kyle Putnam posted his second shutout of the season and Craig Laughland scored the only goal of the game with 12 minutes left, giving the visiting George Fox University Bruins a 1-0 win over the Linfield College Wildcats in a Northwest Conference men's soccer match Friday afternoon here at the Linfield soccer field.

Laughland scored his team-leading 5th goal of the season unassisted in the 78th minute, collecting the ball after a scramble in front of the net and sending it past Wildcat goalkeeper Grant Williams. Linfield had several excellent chances to tie the game with just over one minute remaining, but a hard shot from close range hit the post and the putback attempt bounced off the crossbar and out.

The match was tightly contested, with Linfield holding a narrow 19-15 edge in shots. Williams finished with 7 saves for the Wildcats, but Putnam got the win by making 5 big saves of his own.

The Bruins snapped a five-game losing streak to their Yamhill County counterparts dating back to the 2001 season while improving their overall record to 5-11-2 and their conference record to 4-8-1. The Wildcats slipped to 10-8-1 overall and 8-4-1 in the league.

Both teams end their seasons Saturday at home, George Fox hosting Pacific Lutheran University and Linfield entertaining the University of Puget Sound. Game time at both venues is 1:30 p.m., following women's matches at 11:00 a.m.

10/30 – WILLAMETTE 2, GEORGE FOX 1: Bearcats Build Early Lead to Offset Late Goal by Bruins

SALEM, Ore. – Michael Rodrigues and Mark Conrad each scored unassisted goals as the Willamette University Bearcats built up a 2-0 lead and then held off the George Fox University Bruins in a Northwest Conference men's soccer game Saturday afternoon here at Sparks Field.

Rodrigues scored at the 12:43 mark in the first half to put the Bearcats up 1-0, a lead they would take into halftime. Conrad's goal at 62:27 gave the Bearcats an insurmountable 2-0 lead.

Dan Potter got the Bruins to within a goal when he scored at the 82:24 mark, his fourth goal of the season to tie for the team lead, with an assist from Brian Zaro. The Bearcat defense held firm, however, allowing the Bruins 17 shots but only two on goal for the game. Willamette took 11 shots, eight on goal, with George Fox keeper Kyle Putnam picking up six saves.

George Fox fell to 4-11-2 overall and 3-8-1 in the NWC, while Willamette climbed to 4-12-2 overall and 4-8 in the league. Both teams play again Friday, the Bruins visiting Linfield College and the Bearcats playing at home for the final time this season at McCullough Stadium against Pacific Lutheran University. Both games are at 1:30 p.m. following women's games at 11:00 a.m.

10/27 – PACIFIC 2, GEORGE FOX 1: Boxers Strike Quickly in Second Half to Overcome Bruins

NEWBERG, Ore. – Forward Mark Madeira scored two goals within a two-minute span early in the second half, rallying the Pacific University Boxers to a 2-1 win over the George Fox University Bruins in a Northwest Conference men's soccer match Wednesday afternoon here at Morse Field.

George Fox jumped on top early in the first half when midfielder Brian Zaro intercepted a cleared ball and passed to forward Craig Laughland racing in from the right side. Laughland dribbled in, drawing out goalkeeper Chris Caswell, and angled a shot into the left corner of the net just 7:14 into the game, his 4th goal of the year.

The Boxers got the tying goal at 52:14 in the second half when Jeremy Hinton passed to Madeira just in front of the goalkeeper's box. George Fox keeper Kyle Putnam had stepped out to challenge the play, but slipped in the treacherously-muddy field in front of the net and went down, leaving Madeira to step to the left for an easy tap-in.

Soon thereafter, Caswell sent a kick three-quarters of the length of the field, where Madeira secured it on the left side of the field. He then dribbled around two defenders to midfield and fired a shot into the left side of the net from 15 yards out for his 5th goal of the season and the game-winning shot at the 54:11 mark.

The Bruins had three good chances to tie the rest of the game, including two strong shots by Michael Chapman, but Caswell made fine saves each time to preserve the win. Caswell finished with 7 saves, while Putnam had 8 for the Bruins. Pacific out-shot the Bruins 24-16 overall and had an 11-8 edge in shots on goal.

George Fox is now 4-10-2 overall and 3-7-1 in the conference, while Pacific improves to 6-9 overall and 5-6 in the NWC. The Bruins visit Willamette University Saturday and the Boxers go to Linfield College Sunday, both games at 1:30 p.m. following women's games at 11:00 a.m.

Puget Sound led 23-9 on shots and 15-5 on corners as the Loggers' attack controlled much of the day. Brian Lawson recorded his 4th consecutive shutout by making 3 saves. Putman continued his fine play of late, making 7 saves.

The hard-luck loss drops the Bruins to 4-9-2 overall and to 3-6-1 in the league. The victory pushes the Loggers' record to 10-2-3 overall and 7-2-1 in the NWC. George Fox now hosts Pacific University Wednesday at 4:00 p.m., while the next action for Puget Sound is Saturday against Whitman College at 1:30 p.m. in Tacoma.

10/3 – GEORGE FOX 3, WILLAMETTE 2: Bruins' Early Goals Enough for First NWC Win over Bearcats

NEWBERG, Ore. – Exploding for three goals in the game's first 32 minutes, the George Fox University Bruins needed every one of them to hold off the hard-charging Willamette University Bearcats 3-2 in a Northwest Conference men's soccer contest Sunday afternoon here at Morse Field.

The Bruins dented the scoreboard first just 6:35 into the game when Ryan MacKenzie sent a high kick down the middle of the field and Craig Laughland out-raced two defenders to the ball, then drilled a shot past Willamette keeper Dane Meier for the score, his first of the season. At 13:12, the Bruins' Jon Maroni sent a sharp pass along the left baseline to the front of the net, where Jason Kintner flicked the ball into the left corner for his initial goal.

George Fox's final goal came at 31:06. Max Sorensen sent a corner kick into the middle, where Meier knocked it out of the box, but the Bruins' Brian Zaro corralled the loose ball, dribbled to the right outside corner of the keeper's box, and drilled a hooking shot into the left back for his second goal of the year.

The Bruins took that 3-0 lead into the half, but the Bearcats finally broke through at 55:18 as Reid Bennion scored his second goal of the season off a touch pass from Kyle Gouveia. The visitors narrowed the lead to 3-2 at 72:33 when A.J. Nash notched his first goal, a well-placed header off a corner kick from Pat Wettach.

The Bearcats made a withering assault on the net in the final 17 minutes in an effort to knot the score, getting off 10 of their 18 second-half shots in that stretch and 5 of their 15 total corner kicks, but the Bruin defense and keeper Kyle Putnam were equal to the task, Putnam recording 5 of his 10 saves in that time period. Meier had 9 saves for Willamette as the Bruins finished with 18 shots (12 on goal) to 25 (13 on goal) for the Bearcats.

George Fox improved to 2-6-2 overall and nailed down its first conference win to go to 1-3-1. Willamette slipped to 1-6-2 overall and 1-4 in the league. 9/29 – PACIFIC 2, GEORGE FOX 1: Boxers Break Tie with 18 Minutes Left and Hold On to Beat Bruins

FOREST GROVE, Ore. – Matt McDonough's goal with 18 minutes left in the second half broke a 1-1 tie, and the Pacific University Boxers held on for a 2-1 win over the George Fox University Bruins in Northwest Conference men's soccer action Wednesday afternoon here at Tom Reynolds Field.

McDonough hit the game-winner on a wild set play in the 72nd minute. Bobby Shinn's long throw-in flew to the left side of the goal, glancing off McDonough's head into the goal. The concurrent physical scrum in front of the net sent the Boxers' Randy Shinn to the ground and the goal out of alignment, but both Shinn and the goal escaped without injury.

Pacific had a number of chances in the first half, but did not score until the 40th minute. Bobby Shinn stole the ball in the backfield and sent a pass to Mark Madeira at midfield, who weaved through a pair of defenders on the left side, hitting from 15 yards out for his third goal of the season.

The Bruins' Ben Eichenberger caught the Boxer defense off guard in the 50th minute for the equalizer, weaving through the right side and placing the ball in the left corner of the goal off a pass from Erich Hangartner.

The Bruins nearly took the lead on a pair of free kicks by Max Sorensen. The first, in the 43rd minute, hooked across the penalty area and was just punched off the left corner by Pacific goalie Jory Shene. The second came in the 65th minute, when Sorensen's 20-yard direct kick was blocked away by the Boxer defense before reaching the net.

Shene earned his second win in goal for the Boxers, picking up five saves in the process. Kyle Putnam made seven saves for the Bruins in the loss. The Box out-shot the Bruins 18-8, and also held a 10-6 advantage in corner kicks.

George Fox dipped to 1-6-2 overall and 0-3-1 in the conference. Pacific evened its conference record at 2-2-0 while climbing to 3-5-0 overall.

The Bruins host Willamette University Sunday at 2:30 p.m., following the women's match-up at 12 noon. Pacific will finish up its three-game home stand Saturday with a 2:30 p.m. match-up with Linfield.

In basketball, a player who is fouled is the one who must take the ensuing free throws, unless he is injured or shaken up badly enough to have to come out of the game. In such cases, only his substitute may shoot in his place.

Not so in soccer.

In George Fox's 4-2 loss to #21 Puget Sound on Sunday in Newberg, with the Bruins trailing 1-0 midway through the first half, senior midfielder **Jason Kintner** was grabbed by his shirt and dragged to the ground by a Logger defender as he attempted to make a game-tying shot inside the goalkeeper's box. A red card was given to the UPS defender and a penalty kick was awarded - but instead of Kintner taking the shot, it was freshman defender **Ryan MacKenzie**.

"No, that's not at all unusual," replied George Fox coach **Manfred Tschan** when asked about the play later. "Anyone on the field who wants to take the shot can step up and take it - even the goalkeeper!"

The reasoning behind this, explains Tschan, is that "a player who is fouled in that situation may still be a bit upset about the foul, or he may be slightly injured, or he might be having a bad day and be too agitated to take the shot."

There seems to be no particular criteria for deciding who gets the shot, at least not for Coach Tschan. "Well, obviously you want someone who is confident in their scoring ability, and someone who is having a pretty good game," he says, "but other than that, it's usually just whoever thinks he can make it. Some of the best kickers are defenders, and Ryan felt comfortable that he could make it; since he was the first one to step forward, I said 'Go for it'."

So MacKenzie went for it - and got it as the Puget Sound keeper anticipated and dove to his right, only to have the line drive pass him on the left. MacKenzie later scored his second goal of the game and third of the season in the second half.

NEWBERG, Ore. – In a very physical contest that saw 20 fouls called and each team playing part of the game a man short because of red cards, the 21st-ranked University of Puget Sound Loggers outlasted the George Fox University Bruins 4-2 in Northwest Conference men's soccer action Sunday afternoon here at Morse Field.

NEWBERG, Ore. – A pair of goals in the game's first six minutes proved to be just enough for the visiting Northwest College Eagles to slip past the George Fox University Bruins 2-1 in the men's soccer opener for both teams Wednesday afternoon here at Morse Field.

8/6 – NWC POLL: Bruins Hope to Prove 8th-Place Pick in '04 Wrong; UPS a Solid Favorite

NEWBERG, Ore. – With the loss of its top two scorers from the 2003 season, it is perhaps not unexpected that George Fox University would be picked to finish 8th in the 8-team Northwest Conference men's soccer race in the pre-season coaches' poll for 2004 – but veteran coach **Manfred Tschan** believes the defensive strength of his team should help the Bruins spring more than a few upsets this coming fall.

"Most of our best recruits are defenders," says Tschan, who takes a 169-115-13 record at George Fox (and 233-14-22 overall in 21 years) into his 16th season with the Bruins. "Add them to returning Honorable Mention All-Conference player **Brian Zaro** and fifth-year senior **Chris Waters**, who missed all of last year with an injury but was All-Conference two years ago, and we're going to be strong defensively. Our offensive players are going to have to step up and give us some help, but we won't allow many goals this year."

The Bruins, coming off a 5-12-2 season and a 7th-place finish at 2-10-2 in the NWC in 2003, received 13 votes in balloting by the league's coaches, according to information released by NWC information director Steve Flegel at Whitworth College. Goalkeeper Ron Besser (HM All-NWC) and forward Derek Dougherty (4 goals, 3 assists) have graduated and midfielder Kris Van Houten (HM All-NWC, 6 goals, 9 assists) has transferred to a school in California, but the Bruins still have 17 letterwinners and 8 starters back to help their chances of finishing higher than predicted.

Led by the returning NWC Offensive Player of the Year, the University of Puget Sound is a strong favorite to unseat defending champion Linfield College and claim the NWC men's soccer title this season. The Loggers, who were edged by the Wildcats in the 2003 final standings by a single point, claimed five first place votes and 66 total points. UPS was followed in the poll by Whitworth College and Linfield.

Senior forward Tyler Niemack, the defending Offensive Player of the Year in the NWC, will lead Puget Sound in 2004. The Logger, who finished 13-3-3 overall and 10-1-3 (33 points) in the NWC, will also welcome back First Team All-NWC midfielder Anthony Fioretti.

Whitworth finished second in the poll with 54 points and one first place vote. The Pirates were third in the final NWC standings last fall with an overall record of 12-5-1 and an NWC mark of 9-4-1. Whitworth welcomes back a pair of First Team All-NWC players in senior midfielder Brad Suhm and junior defender Todd Sabrowski.

Linfield, which finished 16-3-1 overall (11-2-1 NWC, 34 points) last season and lost in the first round of the NCAA tournament to UC Santa Cruz, must replace three graduated First Team All-NWC players. Senior midfielder Aleko Lilly was a Second Team choice in 2003 and will return, however. The Wildcats are third in the poll with two first place votes and 47 total points.

Only two points separated third from fourth place in the poll. Pacific Lutheran University surprised many by finishing fourth in the final conference standings last fall with records of 11-7-2 and 7-5-2. The Lutes hope to continue their climb behind All-NWC midfielder Jay Pettit.

Willamette University finished fifth in the poll with 31 points. The Bearcats (8-8-3 overall, 7-6-1 NWC in 2003) must replace graduated Ben DeSanno and Adam Moshofsky, who scored nine goals apiece last fall and were named First Team All-NWC.

Pacific University and Whitman College tied for sixth in the poll with 20 points. Both the Boxers (6-12, 3-11) and Missionaries (6-13, 2-12) graduated their All-NWC selections from a year ago.

George Fox opens its season on Wednesday, Sept. 1, with a home game against Northwest College at 3:00 p.m.

8/6 – RECRUITING: Bruins' Top Recruits for 2004 Expected to Strengthen Team Defense

NEWBERG, Ore. – If the top new recruits for the George Fox University men's soccer team pan out the way head coach **Manfred Tschan** hopes they will, the Bruins expect to be a much-improved defensive squad during the 2004 season.

Redmond (Ore.) High School, which fell to South Medford 1-0 in double overtime in the state 4A title game last fall, will send three of its defenders to the Bruins: **Chase Delashmutt**, **Ryan MacKenzie**, and **Jon Maroni**. **Jonathan Zurcher** from Parkrose High in Gresham, Ore., is another new defender and all-around athlete who may also play tennis while at George Fox. From across the state line comes **Andrew Hammond** from Sammamish (Wash.) High, yet another defender.

Kyle Putnam, a rangy 6-6 goalkeeper with a wide arm span, joins the team from Mountain View High in Bend, Ore., and is expected to challenge for significant playing time with the graduation of Honorable Mention All-Northwest Conference keeper Ron Besser. His high school teammate, **Matt Chang**, also comes to the Bruins with the versatility to play at either defender or midfielder.

The Bruins' top two scorers from last season are gone, with Honorable Mention All-NWC midfielder Kris Van Houten (6 goals, 9 assists) transferring to a school in California, and forward Derek Dougherty (4 goals, 3 assists) graduating and joining the George Fox staff as an assistant coach this year. Taking up some of the slack, the most offensive-minded newcomer for the Bruins will be **Erich Hangartner**, who can play at either midfielder or forward, from Crater High in Central Point, Ore.

Because George Fox is an NCAA Division III program, the Bruins can give no athletic scholarships, but are permitted to provide scholarships and other financial assistance for academic purposes only. All the athletes above are officially enrolled at the university for the coming year.

The Bruins return 17 letterwinners and 8 starters for 2004 in an effort to improve on a 5-12-2 campaign and a 7th-place finish in the NWC at 2-10-2. One key addition to the roster this season is fifth-year senior **Chris Waters** (Boise, Idaho), an All-Conference defender two years ago who missed all of last season with a knee injury. He will join with sophomore defender **Brian Zaro** (Beaverton, Ore.), an Honorable Mention All-NWC performer last year, to anchor the George Fox defense.

Tschan enters his 16th season as the Bruins' coach with a 169-115-13 record at George Fox, and an overall mark of 233-144-22 in 21 years that includes stints at Concordia University-Portland and with the women's team at the University of Oregon.

Players report to school for physicals on Aug. 20 and begin practice on Aug. 21, with the first game set for Wednesday, Sept. 1, against Northwest College from Kirkland, Wash. Game time is 3:00 p.m. at the Bruins' Morse Soccer Field.

MANFRED TSCHAN

Head Men's Soccer Coach

Entering his 16th year as the head men's soccer coach at George Fox University, Manfred Tschan has established the Bruins as one of the most competitive programs in the Pacific Northwest and the nation.

Tschan's teams have gone 169-115-13 in his 15 seasons at George Fox, a .591 winning percentage. From 1991-98, the Bruins' last eight seasons in the NAIA, they were ranked in the Top 25 at some point in six of those years. Under his guidance, George Fox has finished first or second in its district or conference 10 times. The team also received national exposure by winning two National Christian College Athletic Association national championships (1988 and 1990) and making one NAIA National Tournament appearance (1993). In 1993, he won NAIA District 2 and NAIA Area 1 "Coach of the Year" honors. Nine of his players earned NAIA All-American awards.

A former player in the Swiss First Junior and First Amateur divisions, the 48-year-old Tschan has 21 years of coaching experience. Prior to settling in Newberg, he held head coaching positions at Concordia University-Portland (1984-87) and the University of Oregon (1980-81). During his two seasons at Oregon, the Swiss native guided the fledgling women's program to a No. 4 Intercollegiate Soccer Association of America national ranking and into the 1981 AIAW National Tournament. His 27-3-3 record at Oregon, along with 37-26-5 mark in four seasons at Concordia and his George Fox days, give him an overall career record of 233-144-22, a percentage of .612.

An assistant professor of health and human performance at George Fox, Tschan earned a bachelor of science degree in education in 1976 from The Teachers' College of Hofwil, Switzerland, a master of science degree in motor learning from the University of Oregon, and has completed Ph.D. course work in sports psychology. He is fluent in German, French and English, and has been published in numerous journals and newspapers in Switzerland and the United States.

Coach Tschan and his wife Vicki, who is the student loans coordinator at George Fox, reside in Newberg and have two children: Twila, 14, and Heidi, 12.
