Honorable Mention: Courtney Johnson (PLU, P) had 26 points, 17 rebounds and 14 blocks in two Lute victories; Chrissy Oneal (Whitworth, P) totaled 30 points and 11 rebounds in two Pirate wins; Megan Higgins (Whitman, G) led the Missionaries to two victories with 26 points, nine rebounds and nine assists; Kristine Callan (Pacific, G) scored 24 points off of the bench in a pair of losses; Heidi Jurgens (Linfield, G) had 12 points and four rebounds in a loss.

Notes: No NWC team was ranked in the latest D3hoops.com poll . . . George Fox was ranked 6th and Pacific Lutheran was 7th in the latest NCAA West Region Poll. . . Courtney Johnson went into the weekend leading the nation in blocked shots before picking up 14 more . . . Liz Clark of George Fox had 17 rebounds on Saturday vs. Whitworth.

NWC Women's Swimmer of the Week: Amy Singleton (Linfield, Sr., Yreka, Calif.) won three individual events and was on two winning relays to lead the Wildcats to a pair of dual meet victories. She won the 100 Breaststroke (1:11.61) vs. Willamette and won the 200 Free (2:06.00) and 200 Breast (2:33.59) vs. PLU.

Honorable Mention: Kristen Satterfield (Whitworth) won the 100 (54.49) and 200 (1:57.44) Freestyles vs. Seattle.

NWC Men's Swimmer of the Week: Ben Karlin (Linfield, Fr., Lake Oswego, Ore.) won all four of his individual events in a sweep of dual meets. He won the 50 (22.12) and 100 (49.37) Freestyles vs. Willamette and won the same events (22.29 and 48.48) vs. Pacific Lutheran.

Honorable Mention: Kevin Wang (Whitworth) won the 1,650 Free (15:59.73), 200 I.M. (1:55.82) and 500 Free (4:39.86) in a loss to Seattle; Aaron Hesla (PLU) won the 400 I.M. (4:27.69) in a loss at Linfield.

Notes: Upon further review it was discovered that one of Whitworth's men's swimmers was not ineligible during fall meets (as was wrongly reported in January). Therefore the Pirates did not forfeit four dual meet victories.
