Leading the Coyotes to a perfect 3-0 week, Wilson helped secure the second seed in the upcoming CCC playoffs for Albertson. Wilson scored 83 points (27.7 ppg) on 25 of 48 shooting (.521), including 13 of 28 (.464) three-point shooting. Wilson also broke a string of 51 consecutive made free throws, one short of the NAIA all-time mark. For the week he was 20-22 (.909). He also grabbed 23 rebounds (7.7 rpg), handed out 12 assists, blocked five shots and had four steals.
